A Challenge to Jesus' Authority & The Question about John the Baptist

Mark 11:27-33

Theme: Having demonstrated His messianic authority by clearing the temple, Jesus is questioned by the religious leaders about the source of His authority. Recognizing this as an attempt to trap Him, Jesus counters by asking whether John the Baptist's authority was from God or of human origin. Their unwillingness to answer reveals Jesus' superior wisdom and exposes them as hypocrites and fraudulent leaders.
