The Parable of the Persistent Widow "A Story for Those Who Think God Isn't Listening"

Luke 18:1-8 September 15, 2019

Theme: Jesus tells the story of a widow whose situation looked hopeless. She was facing an unjust system and an uncaring judge. Yet her persistence and persevering faith eventually resulted in the justice she desired. Jesus' application is clear: If this woman's persistent requests to an unjust judge resulted in an answer, how much more will our prayers of faith to our loving heavenly Father be answered.
