"Desperate Times Call for Desperate Measures: When God Shows Up at the Threshing Floor"

Ruth 3:1-18

October 6, 2019

Theme: Spurred on by Naomi's direction, Ruth takes initiative to secure a home and husband for herself and the security this will bring for Naomi. She approaches Boaz when he is sleeping on the threshing floor and requests that he fulfill the role of guardian-redeemer. Boaz sees this request as an even greater example of Ruth's hesed and agrees to move ahead and also sends food home with Ruth for Naomi. Through the faithful actions of the three main characters, God is actively providing for the two women.

 - a. More food: No longer empty! (v. 16-17; cf. 1:21)
 - b. Cliff-hanger: "the man will not rest until the matter is settled today" (v. 18)

<u>Take-Away:</u> In this story, God proves trustworthy to care for those who are most vulnerable—the foreigner and the widow (à la Deuteronomy). Naomi and Ruth, in their desperate situation, are pressed toward a potentially risky plan to request Boaz to be their guardian-redeemer. God honors their actions—actions that illustrate above-and-beyond loyalty and kindness. The call to us is to look for divine faithfulness in unlikely places and to trust God, as well as to commit ourselves toward living out *hesed* even when it's difficult or risky.
