## PROFESSION OF FAITH

1689 Baptist Confession of Faith: Chapter 07, Paragraph 01 & 03

Leader:

Though rational creatures are responsible to obey God as their Creator, the distance between God and these creatures is so great that they could never have attained the reward of life except by God's voluntary condescension. He has been pleased to express this through a covenant framework.

Congregation: "For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people." - Jeremiah 31:33

Leader:

This covenant is revealed in the gospel. It was revealed first of all to Adam in the promise of salvation through the seed of the woman. After that, it was revealed step by step until the full revelation of it was completed in the New Testament. This covenant is based on the eternal covenant transaction between the Father and the Son concerning the redemption of the elect.

Congregation: "Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, but share in suffering for the gospel by the power of God, Who saved us and called us to a holy calling, not because of our works but because of His own purpose and grace, which He gave us in Christ Jesus before the ages began." - 2 Timothy 1:8-9

In 1689, greater freedom was given to dissenting ministers in England and the Second London Confession was republished and signed. It is called the 1689 Baptist Confession of Faith.

### MISSIONARY REPORT

David and Holly Porch // West Africa

The Porch family lives among the unreached in West Africa. They are currently in Alabama on home ministry assignment, but are preparing to return to West Africa at the end of the month. They are grateful for the time they were able to spend with Grace Fellowship last month. Below are some of the things they were able to share with us.

David shared more details about his work with the Basic Wolof Bible Translation project. The translation team is working to adapt the Wolof Bible (which has yet to be published in its entirety) into a more modern Wolof that the majority of the people can understand. David's role on the translation team is to ensure that the team understands the meaning of the original Hebrew text so that they can choose the most appropriate Wolof terminology for their translation of the Old Testament. The team is preparing for a final consultant check for Genesis 12-50 during the month of November. David is also involved in preaching at their local church and teaching at a local seminary. The seminary is in need of revitalization, so pray for the Lord's will to be done throughout that process.

Holly shared about her work as a nurse and lactation counselor at a local hospital. She enjoys teaching childbirth preparation classes and strives to model compassionate care and speak truth to the staff and midwifery students. She also shared about their language helper who recently heard the truth of Jesus for the first time. David and Holly were able to study the book of Luke with her as they studied the Wolof language together.

David and Holly view their four children as their primary disciples and strive to be available for them when they are home from school. The three oldest Porch children will be transitioning to a new school when they return in November. They are trusting that this new school will be beneficial for everyone, and they are trusting for the Lord to provide the extra funding necessary to cover the increase in tuition.

#### PRAYER

- The advancement of the Wolof Bible translation.
- Growth for David and Holly in their use of the Wolof language and the ability to share the truth of Scripture with people in Wolof.
- Transition back to life in West Africa, including the kids' transition into a new school.
- The Lord will meet their financial needs for the kids' school tuition (\$7,143.00 for the 2025/2026 school year).
- The Lord will continue to use local believers like Esther (chaplain ministry) and Awa (kids club ministry) to make disciples among the unreached.
