





2. WHO DO YOU LOOK LIKE...

Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: **sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry.** Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: **anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips.** **Do not lie to each other,** since you have taken off your **old self** with its practices and have put on the **new self,** which is being **renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator.** Here there is no Gentile or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but **Christ is all, and is in all.**


COLOSSIANS 3:5-11

KEY WORDS

- **Sexual/Lust/Desires/Greed** (*“For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life. Therefore, anyone who rejects this instruction does not reject a human being but God, the very God who gives you his Holy Spirit.”* I Thess. 4:7-8)
- **Anger/Filthy Language/Lying** (*directed toward another person*)
- **Old Self v New Self**
- **Renewed in Knowledge in our Creator’s Image**

NO DIVISIONS IN THE KINGDOM

- Here there is no **Gentile** or **Jew**, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, **Scythian**, slave or free, but **Christ** is all, and is in all.





3. NEW HEART, NEW CLOTHES

Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, **clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.** Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. **Forgive as the Lord forgave you.** And over all these virtues put on **love**, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

Let the **peace of Christ** rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And **be thankful**. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, **do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus**, giving thanks to **God the Father** through him.
