
#### Acts 20:20






#### What do I smell like? - 2 Cor. 2:14-15

- **A** = Ask (God to have Holy Spirit teach) 1 Cor. 2:10
- **R** = Read (listen, soak and meditate) Ps. 119:97
- Observe (facts: who, what, where, etc.) Matt. 4:4
- M = Meaning (God/Author's intent) Matt. 12:7
- A = Apply (How do I apply to my life) Matt. 7:24-27




#### Am I actively in prayer? - Jas. 5:16b

- **A** = Adore (praise God's attributes) Ps. 141:2
- C = Confess (Jesus as Lord & my sins) Matt. 6:12
- T = Thanks (God's provisions & blessings) Phil. 4:6
  - Intercede (for others' needs) 1 Tim. 2:1
- Opportunity (to serve, bless, witness) Eph. 6:19,20
- Needs (put off my sin, put on holiness) 2 cor. 13:9




#### Are we trying to bear it alone? – Gal. 6:2

- **B** = Bow (humbly submit to each other) Eph. 5:21
- **E** = Encourage (affirm, support, sing, pray) Eph. 5:19
- **A** = Ask (accountability with love / empathy) Gal. 6:1
- **R** = Remember (scriptures, communion) 1 Cor. 11:26



#### Am I on fire for the Lord? – Acts 2:3-4

- **F** = Found (lost now found, sealed by H.S.) Eph. 4:30
- **L** = Learn (His purpose, character) "fruit" Gal. 5:22-25
- **A** = Access (Lordship, sanctification process) 1 Cor. 12:3
- M = Mature (led and instep with the Spirit) Rom. 8:14-16
- **E** = Engage (pray to teach, guide daily) Jn. 14:26; Gal. 5:16



## What am I sharing? - Heb. 13:16

- **S** = Sacrifice (time and energy for others) 1 Pet. 4:9-11
- H = Help (those that are in need / hurting) Acts 2:44-45
- A = Allocate (resources: money / assets) 2 Cor. 9:6-12
- **R** = Reinvest (with younger in age / faith) 1 cor. 4:14-17
- **E** = Evangelism (express the Gospel) 2 cor. 5:17-20
