



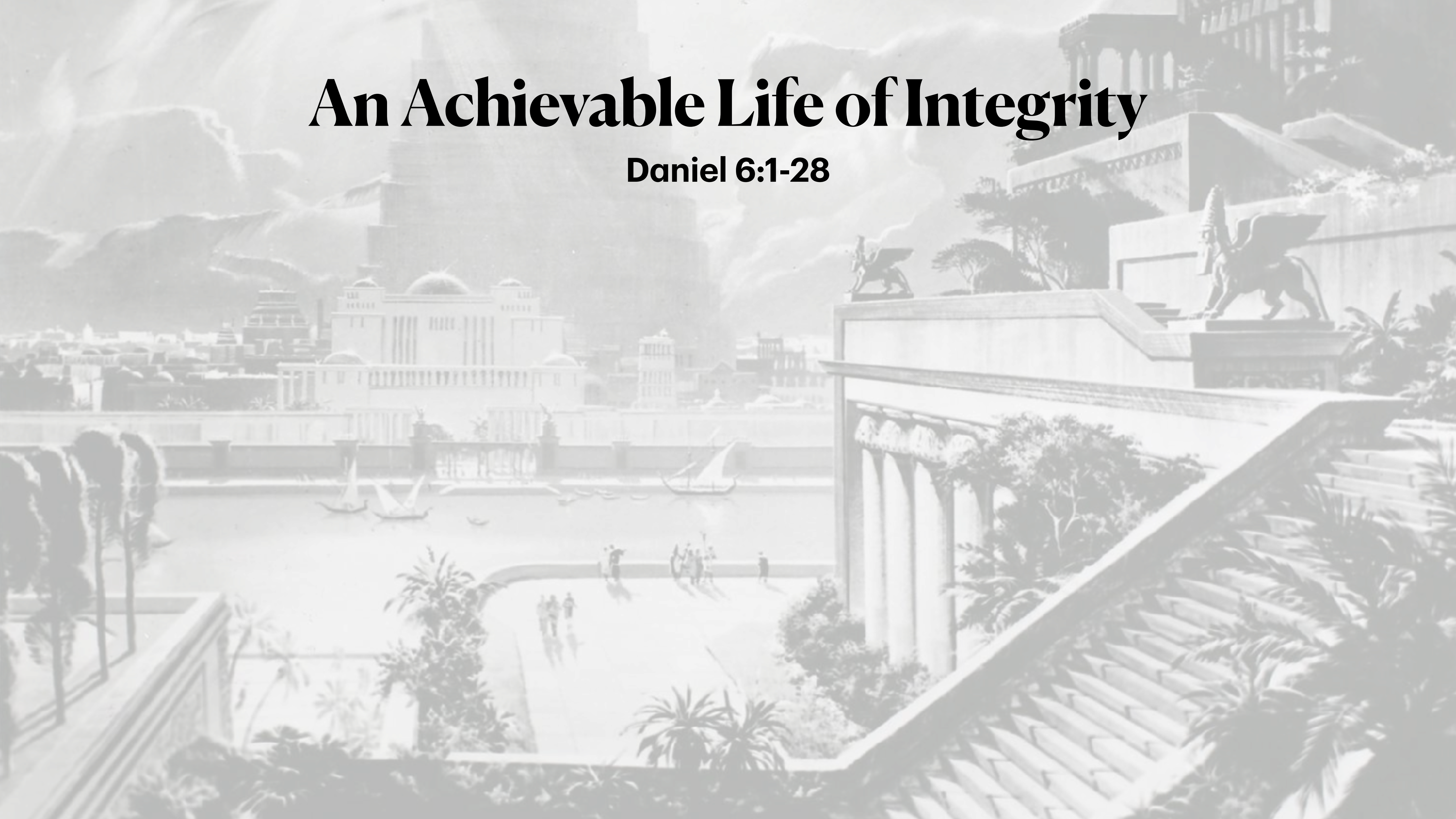

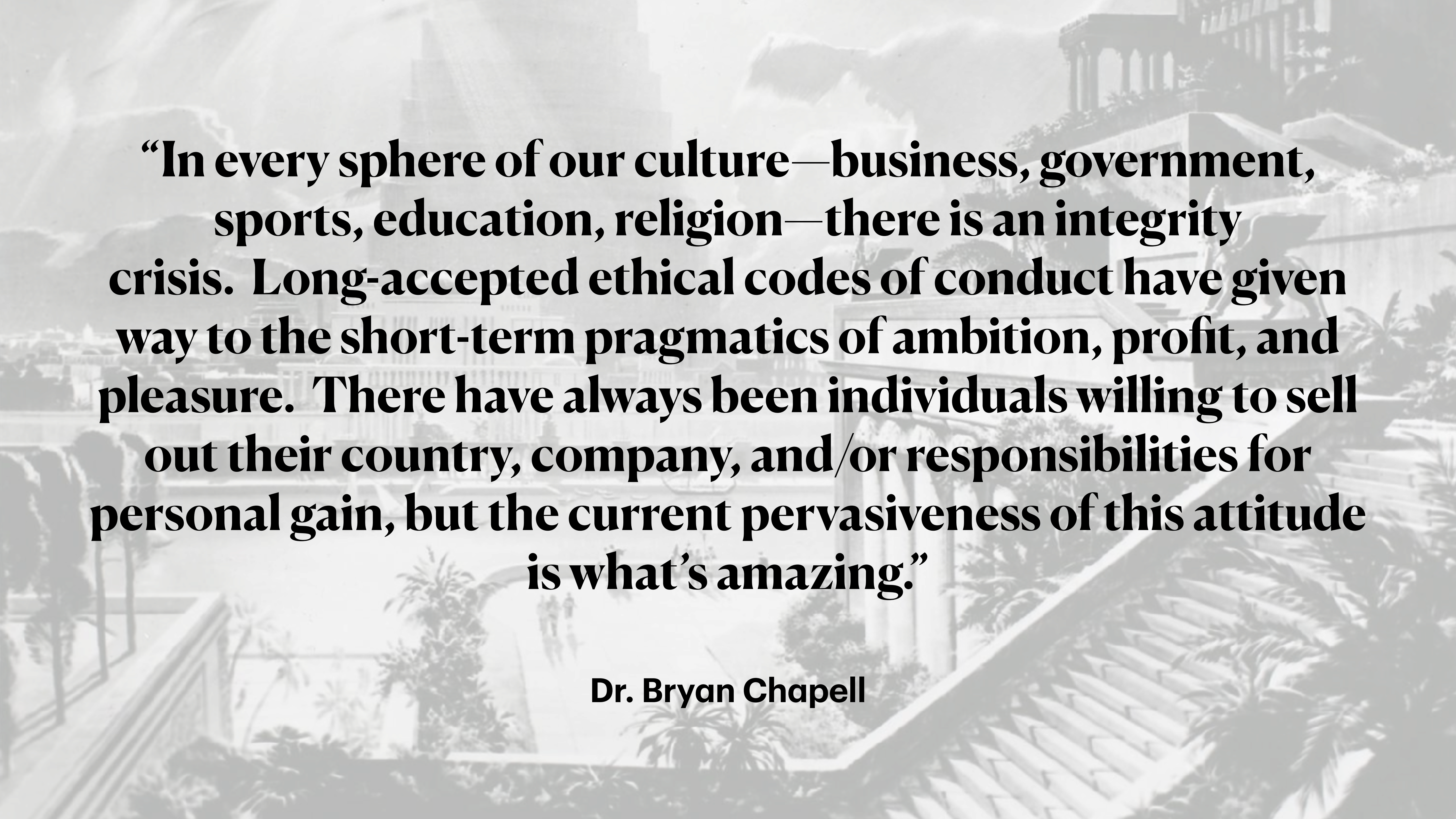

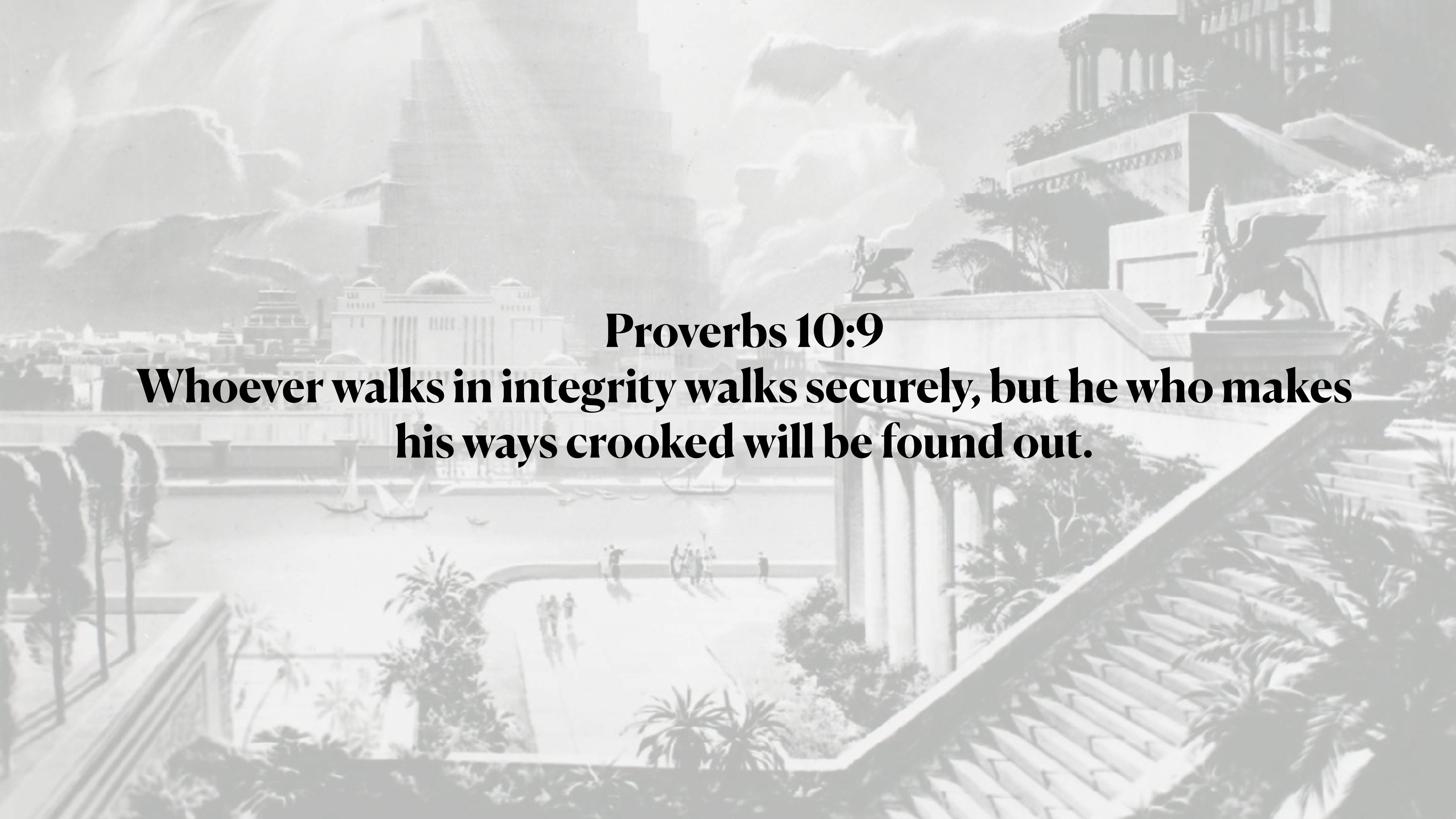
- **A Life Of Integrity Is Noticed 6:1-5**

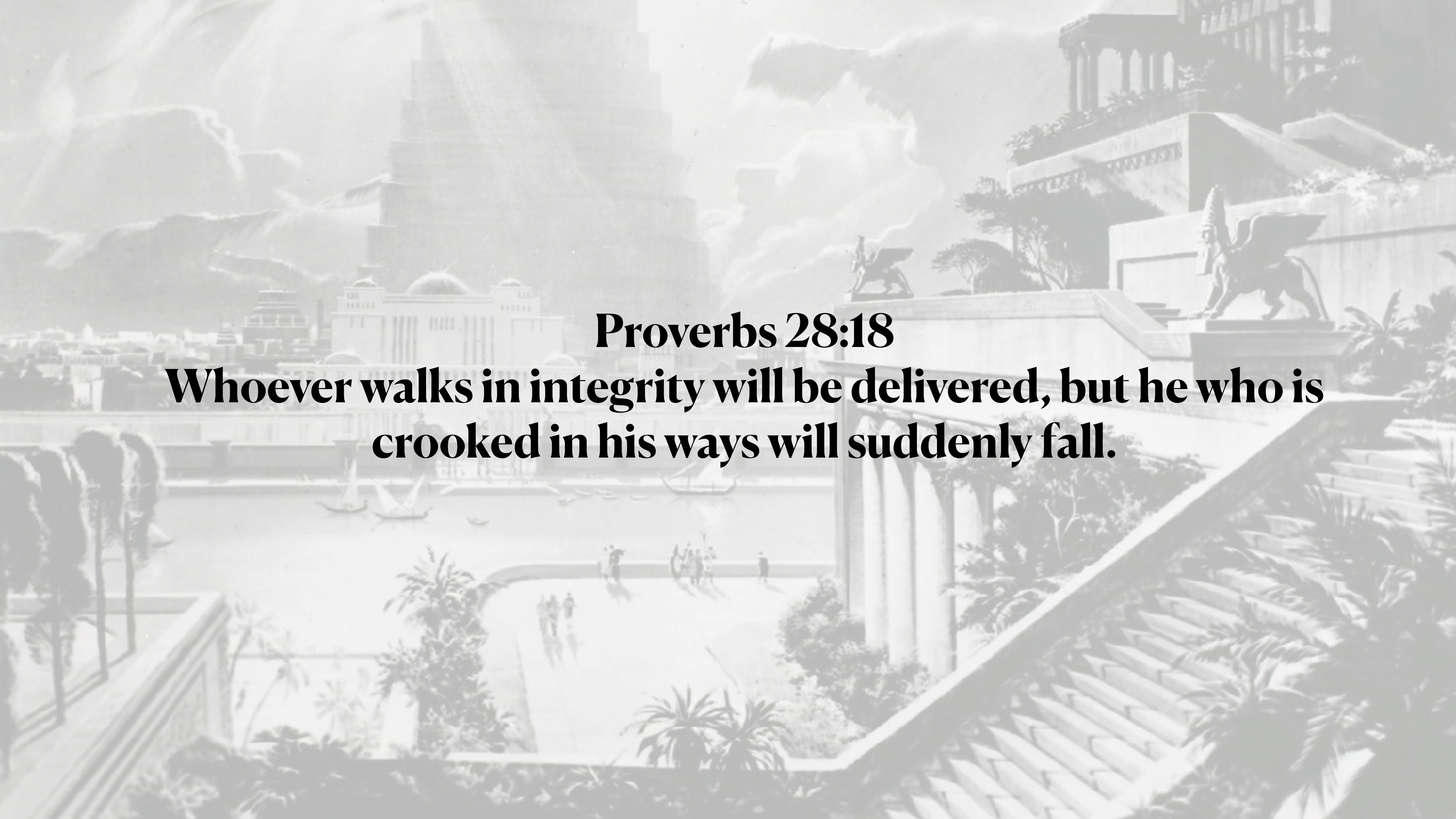

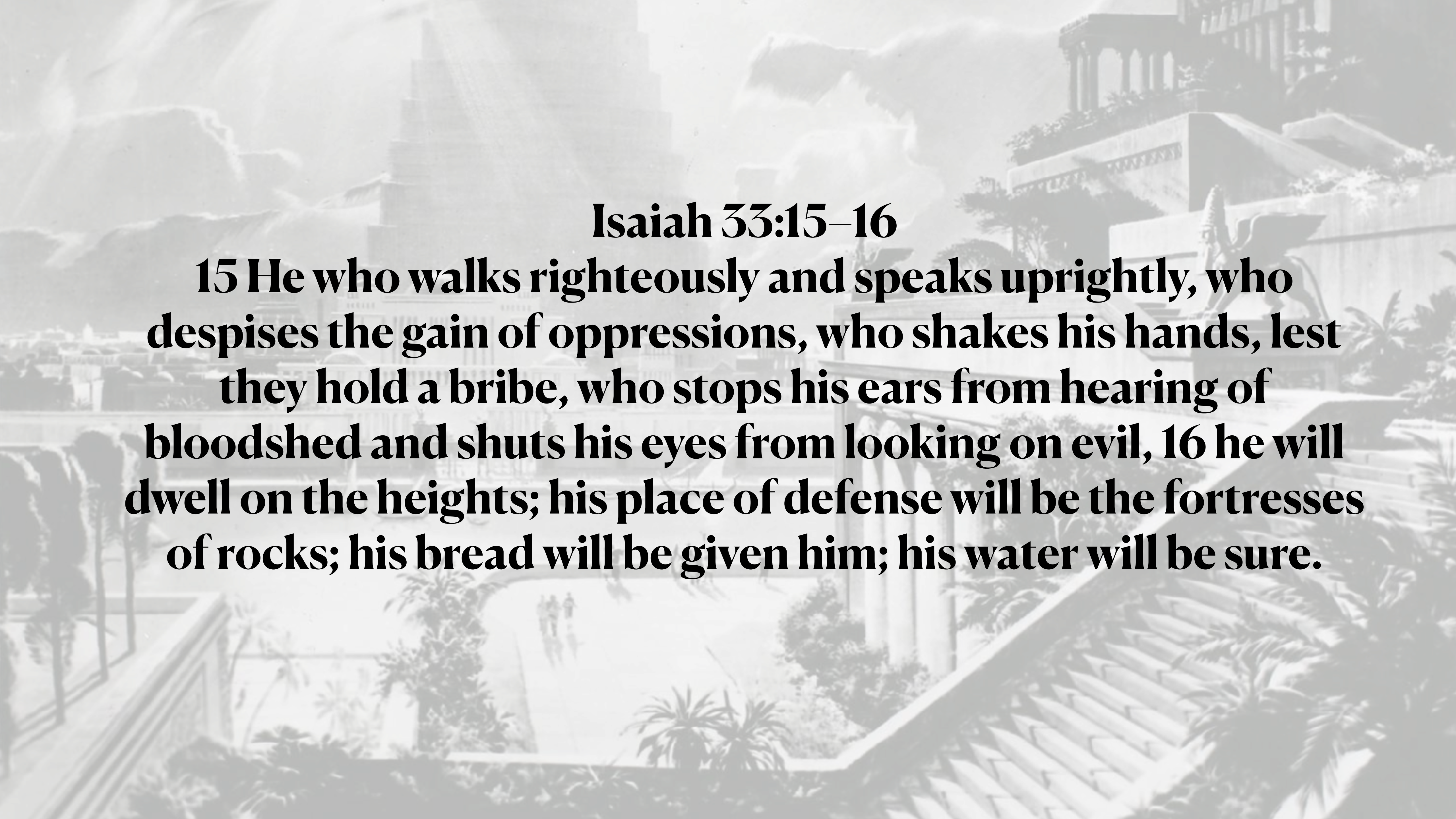
Proverbs 10:9
