1 Corinthians 4:5

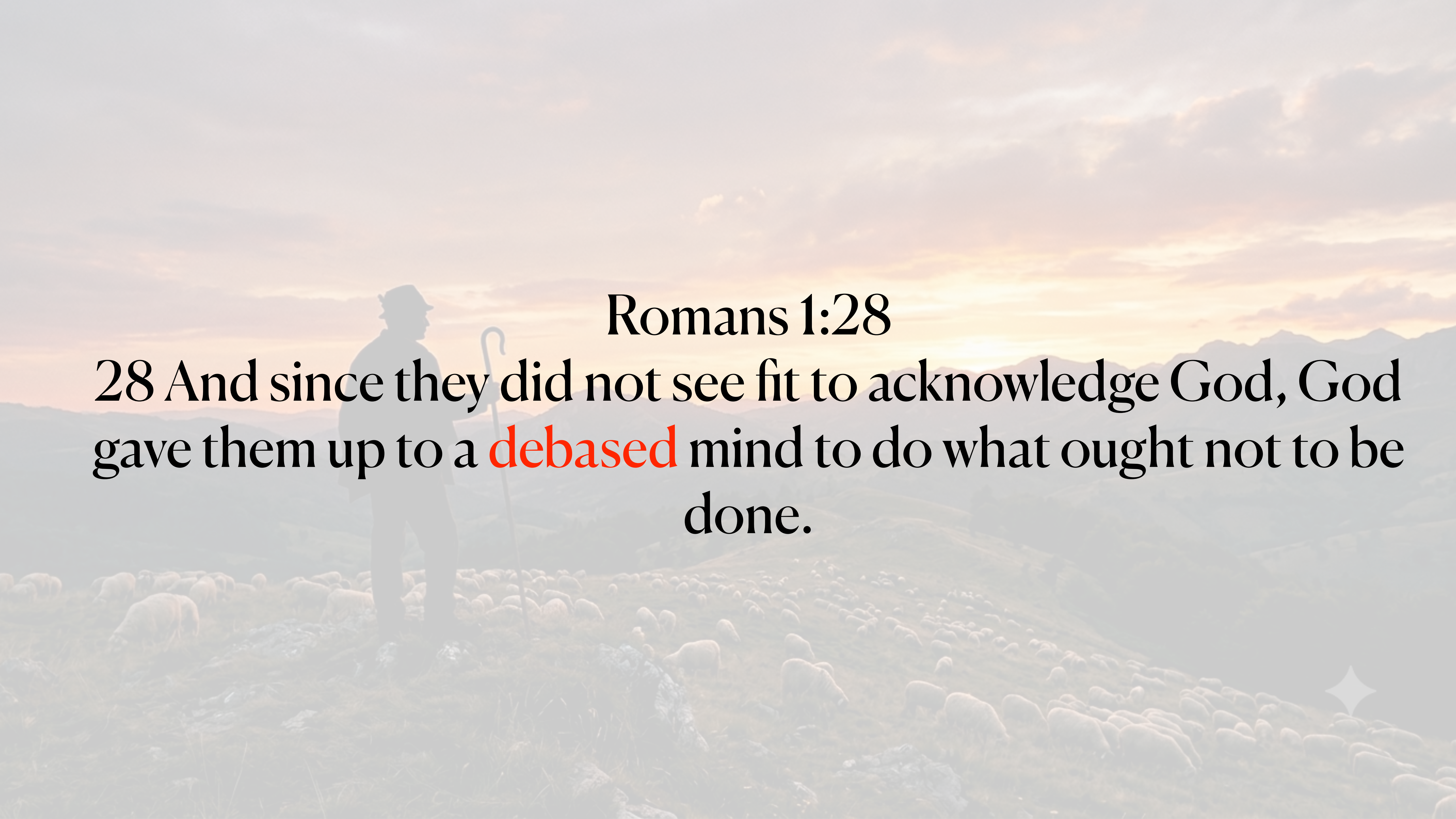

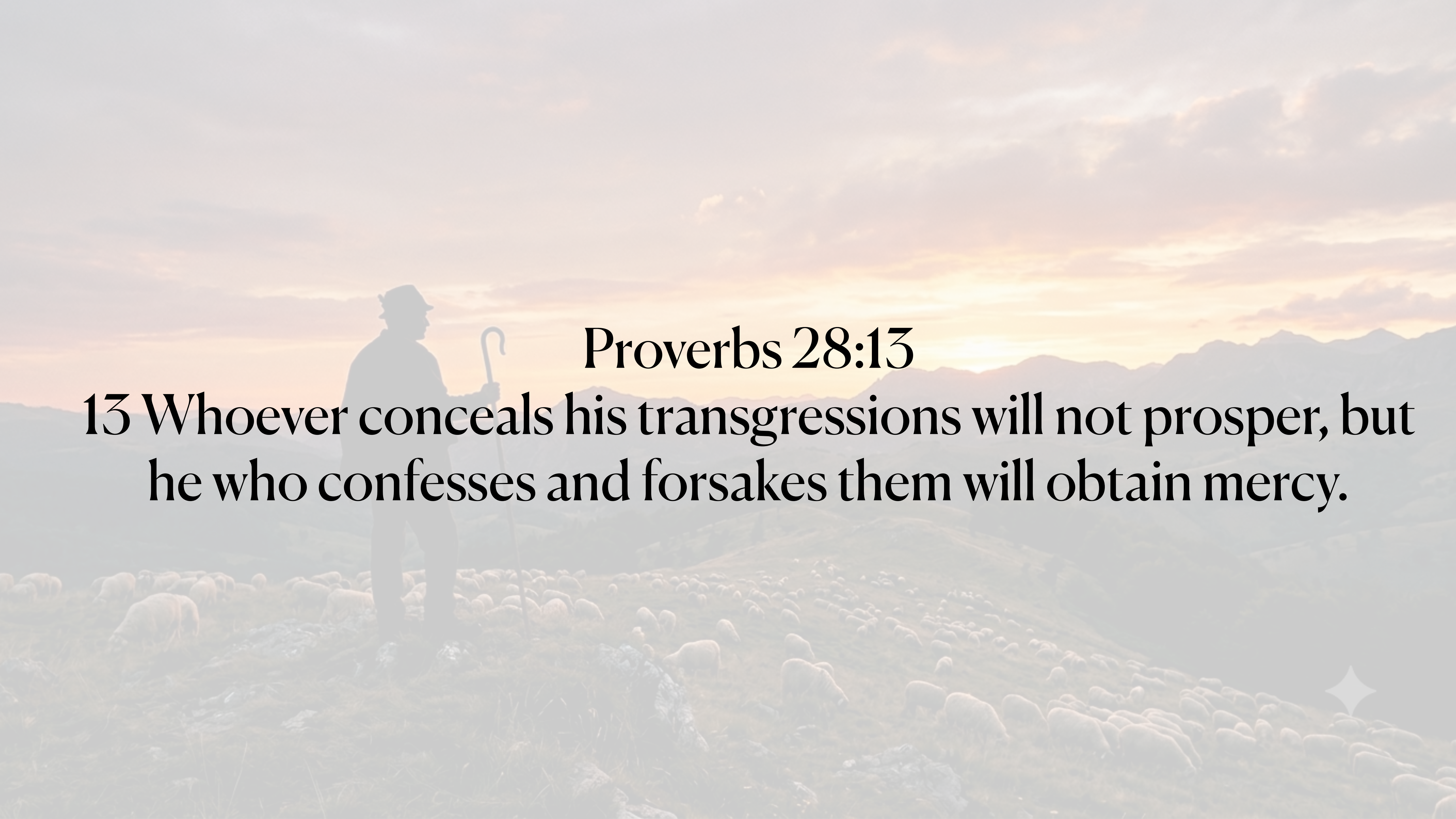

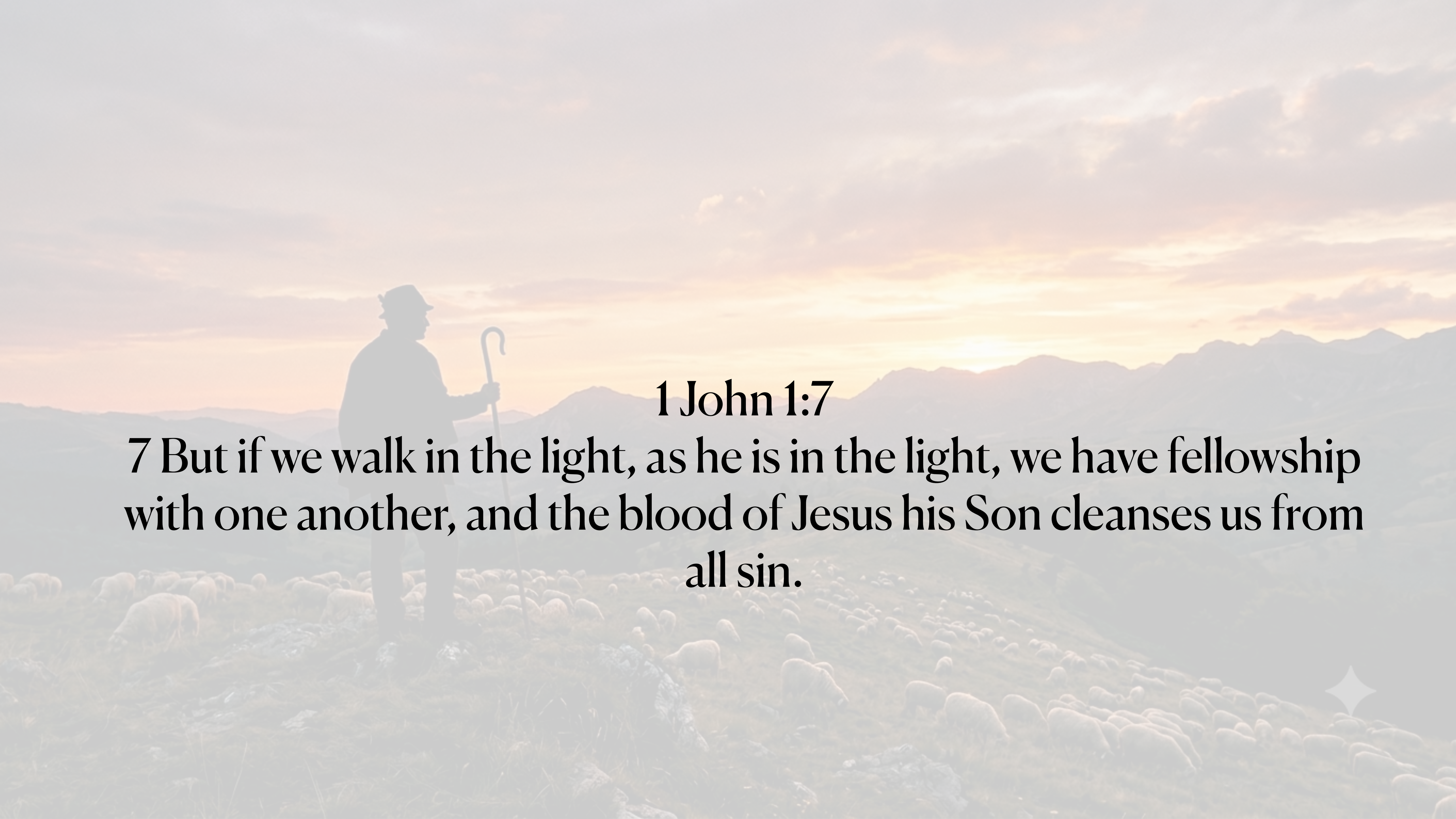
