1. Reflect....How am I doing on living a life of Hope, Holiness, Worship and Love?



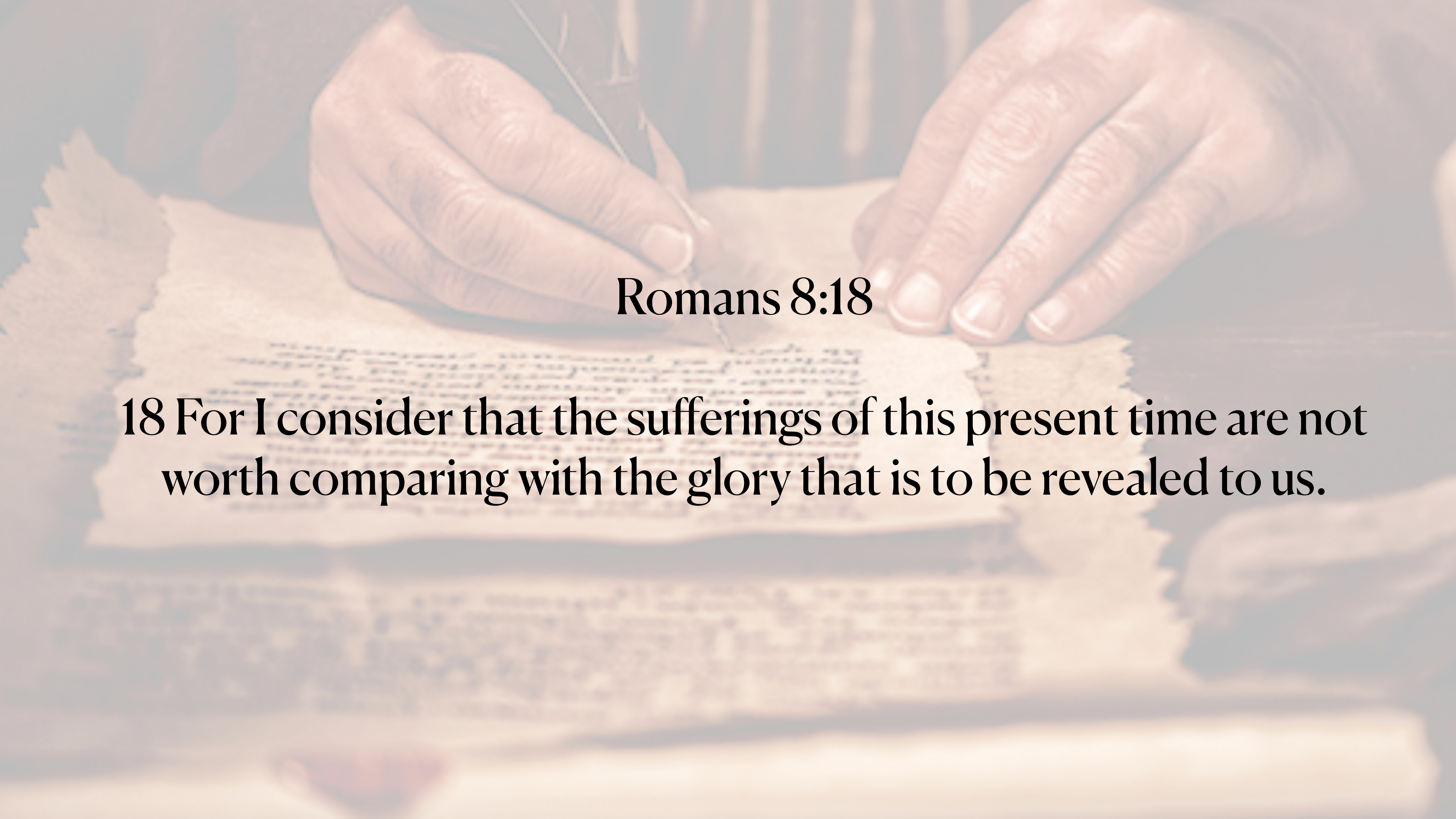
2 Corinthians 3:18
