ICEBREAKER: What is your favorite movie of 2021? What did you enjoy about it?

INTRODUCTION: In one of the first stories of scripture, we are introduced to two brothers: Cain and Abel. Their story, which should have been tremendous, quickly turned tragic. Anger, unmanaged and uncontained morphed into murder. In short, Cain wasn't ABLE to master the mindset that subtly and sinisterly overtook him. Our expectation is a penalty levied upon Cain, but there's a plot twist that only the grace of God can provide.

SCRIPTURE: Read Genesis 4:1-10 (NIV)

DISCUSSION:

- 1. What stood out in today's message? What's one thing you learned? What questions came to mind as you listened to the message today?
- 2. The conflict in this story centers on God's response to the worship of the two brothers. Many judge the spirituality of worship on the basis of their experience. Is this valid in your view? What do you believe is the basis for worship that pleases God?
- 3. Both Cain and Abel made sacrifices to God, but God was only pleased with Abel's sacrifice. Why do you think Abel's sacrifice pleased God? It's ok to speculate because the text does not provide a specific reason.
- 4. Abel received COMMENDATION from God, but CONDEMNATION from Cain. Which do you believe is more important? Which do you think we seek most of the time? How important is the commendation of others to us on a daily basis? How can we know whether or not what we do and say please God?

CHALLENGE: Read Romans 12:1-2. Note all the practical ways we can guard our lives from wrong worship. Commit to putting at least one into action.


