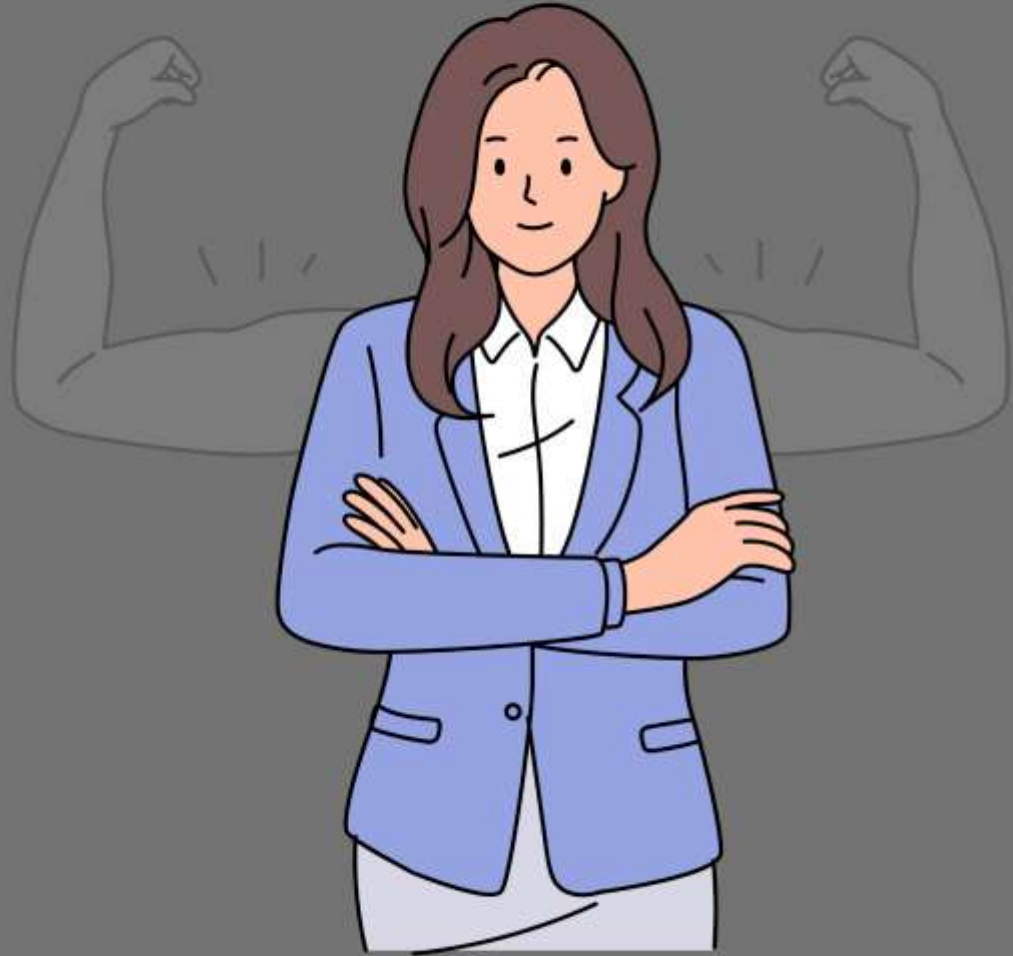

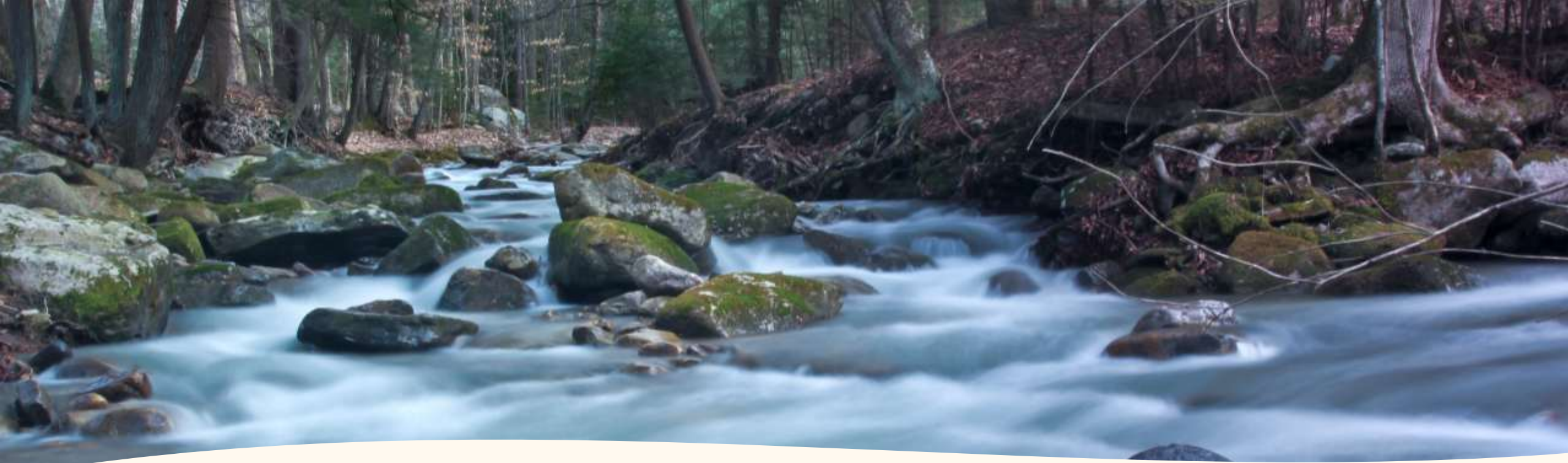


Part 3: The Talent Trap

Relying on the Holy Spirit beyond your natural abilities.

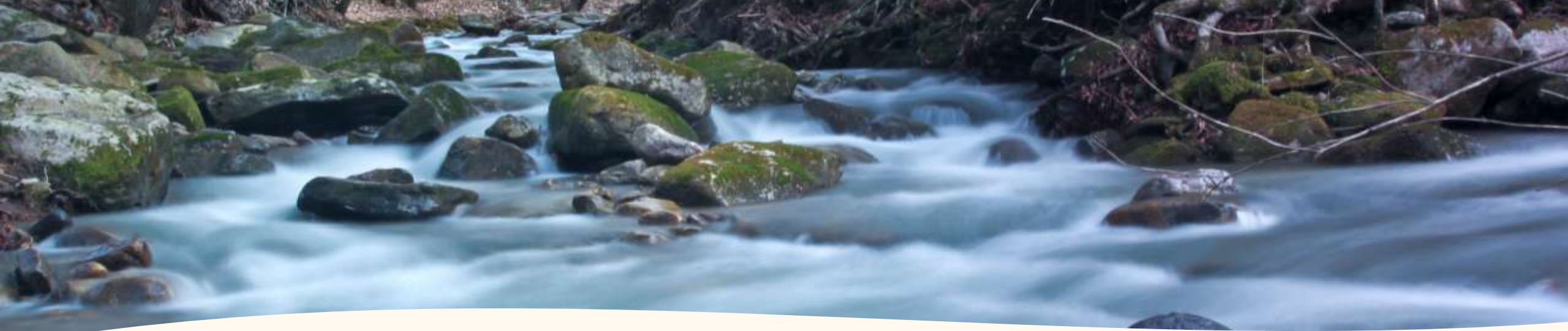

Exodus 4:10–14

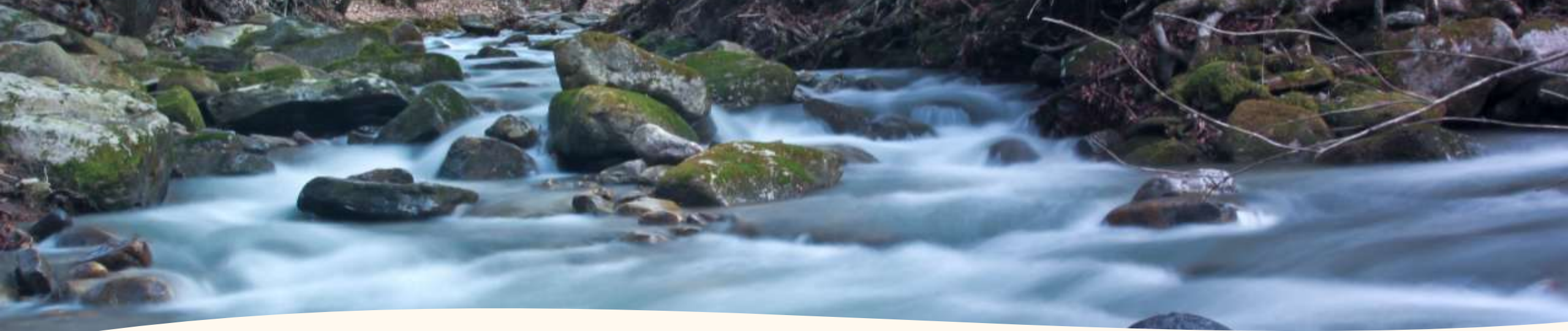

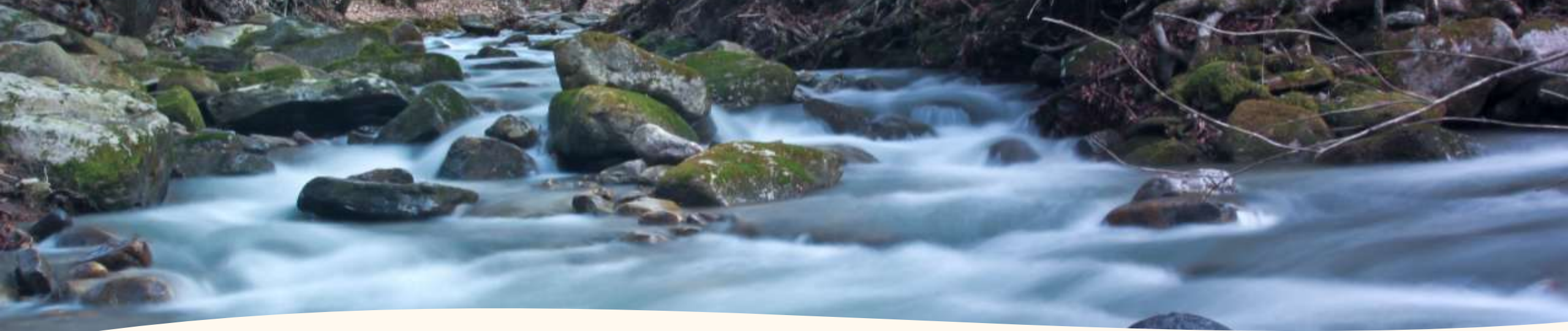
Gideon

¹⁶ The LORD answered, “**I will be with you**, and you will strike down all the Midianites, leaving none alive.” NIV



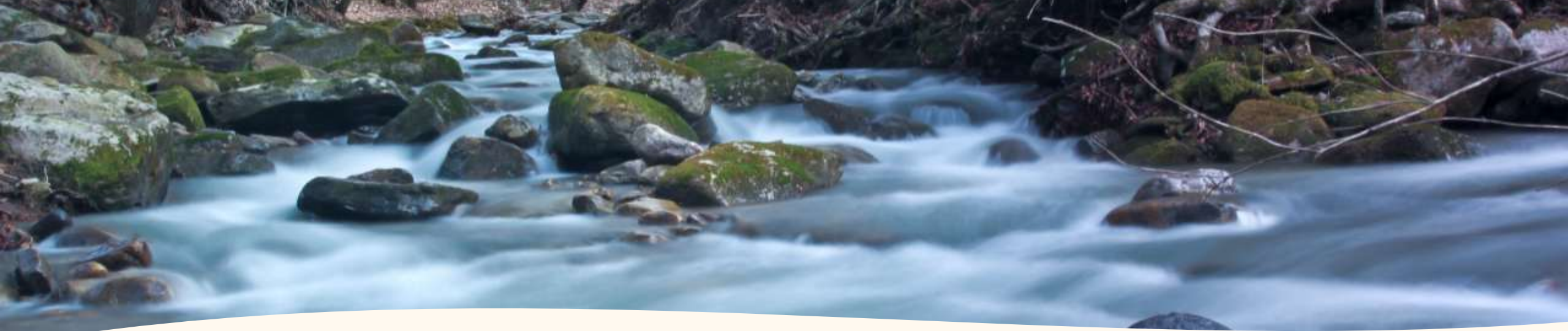
Jeremiah
