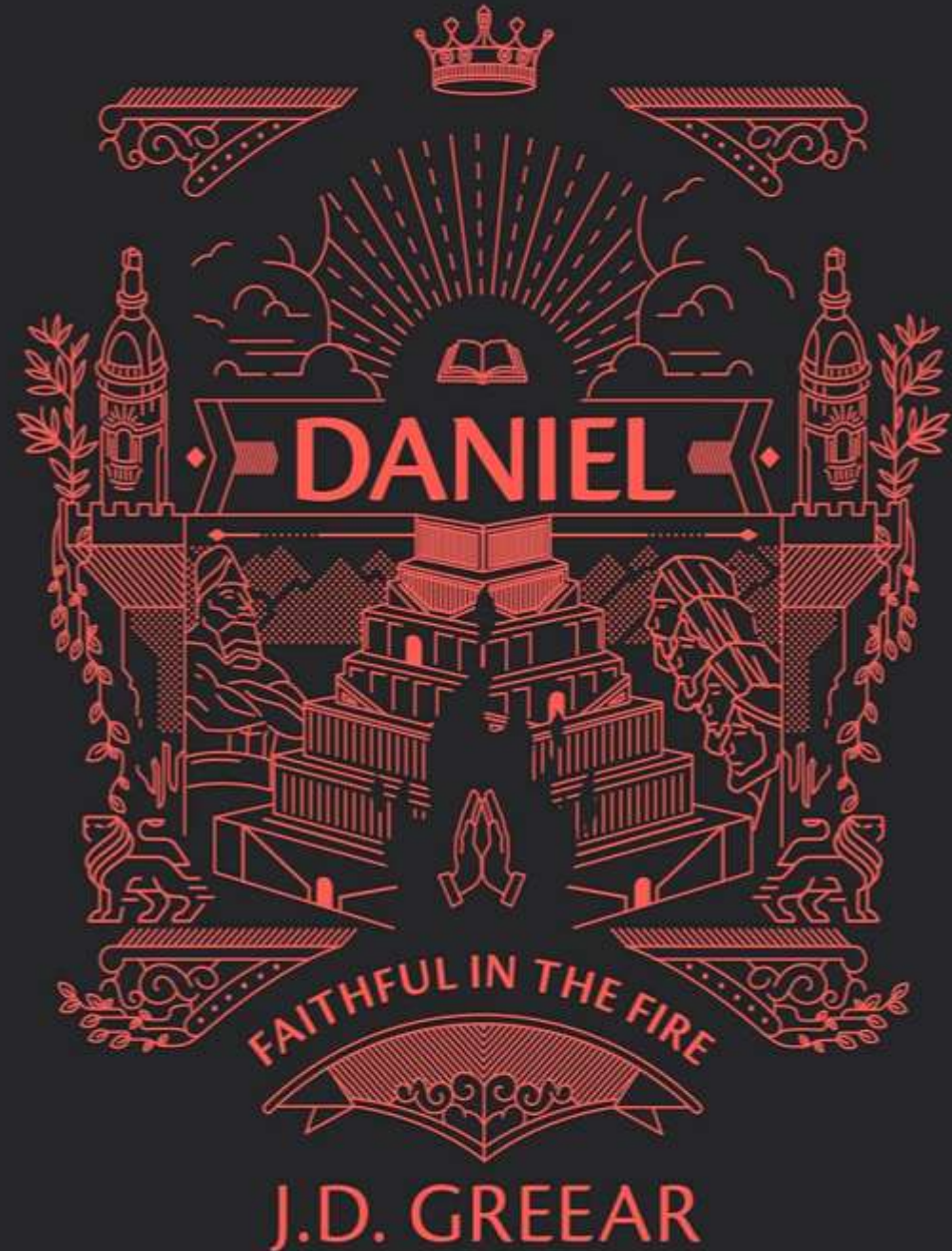

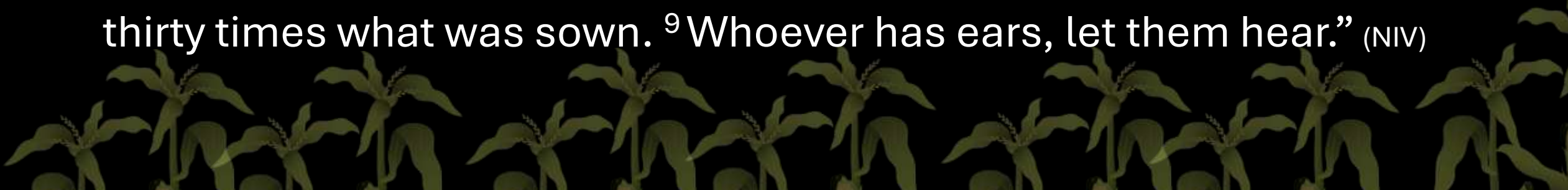

Parable of the Sower: Matthew 13, Mark 4, Luke 8



Matthew 13:3-9



Then he told them many things in parables, saying: “A farmer went out to sow his seed. ⁴ As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. ⁵ Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. ⁶ But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. ⁷ Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants. ⁸ Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop—a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown. ⁹ Whoever has ears, let them hear.” (NIV)







Parable of the Sower: Matthew 13, Mark 4, Luke 8



Matthew 13:1-9

¹⁰ The disciples **came to him and asked**, “Why do you speak to the people in parables?”

¹¹ He replied, “Because the knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you, but not to them. ¹² Whoever has will be given more, and they will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them. (NIV)





Different Types of Soil

(Matthew 13)



Soil on the Path

¹⁸ “Listen then to what the parable of the sower means:

¹⁹ When anyone hears the message about the kingdom and **does not understand it**, the evil one comes and snatches away what was sown in their heart. This is the seed sown along the path.


Rocky Soil

²⁰ The seed falling on rocky ground refers to someone who hears the word and at once receives it with joy.

²¹ But since they have no root, they last only a short time. **When trouble or persecution comes because of the word**, they quickly fall away.

Thorns

²² The seed falling among the thorns refers to someone who hears the word, but **the worries of this life and the deceitfulness of wealth choke the word**, making it unfruitful.



Good Soil

Matthew 13:23

“But the seed falling on good soil refers to someone who **hears the word** and **understands it**. This is the one who produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown.”



Good Soil

Mark 4:20

Others, like seed sown on good soil, hear the word, **accept it**, and produce a crop—some thirty, some sixty, some a hundred times what was sown.”



Good Soil

Luke 8:15

But the seed on good soil stands for those with a **noble and good heart**, who hear the word, **retain it**, and **by persevering** produce a crop.

Becoming Good Soil

Psalm 1

¹ Blessed is the one
who does not walk in step with the wicked
or stand in the way that sinners take
or sit in the company of mockers,
² but whose delight is in the law of the LORD,
and who **meditates on** his law **day and night**.
³ That person is like **a tree planted by streams of water**,
which yields its fruit in season
and whose leaf does not wither—
whatever they do prospers.
⁴ Not so the wicked!
They are like chaff
that the wind blows away.
⁵ Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment,
nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.
⁶ For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous,
but the way of the wicked leads to destruction.

Becoming Good Soil
