MAIN IDEA

You will live like a SLAVE until you know who you BELONG to.

THE STORY

Egypt was provision for a season. Egypt was never the PROMISE.

"Look, the people of Israel now outnumber us and are stronger than we are."

EXODUS 1:9

1. YOUR DESTINY IS NOT SLAVERY IN EGYPT.

Prominent thought: What happened to you does not get to decide who God says you are.

NEBO CROSSING

Moses saw the Promised Land from Mount Nebo, but he did not cross into it. Joshua led the next generation across. We are NEBO CROSSING: crossing over into God's promises.

LEGACY: It stops with me. I am not staying in Egypt. I am CROSSING over.

2. THE ENEMY ATTACKS WHAT GOD SAYS IS TRUE.

Key question: WHO GETS TO TELL ME WHO I AM?

God: "This is my beloved Son..." • Satan: "If you are the Son of God..."

MATTHEW 3:17 • 4:3

3. WHAT THE ENEMY CAN'T STOP, HE WILL TRY TO ENSLAVE.

Pharaoh did not remove their strength. He reallocated it.

WHO IS GETTING YOUR BRICKS?

4. SLAVERY ALWAYS WANTS MORE.

What you tolerate as a master will eventually demand more from you.

5. FEAR GOD MORE THAN PHARAOH.

Shiphrah and Puah feared God and refused Pharaoh's order. Egypt remembers kings. God remembers faithfulness.

"This is what the LORD says: Israel is my firstborn son."

EXODUS 4:22

PHARAOH SAID SLAVE. GOD SAID SON.

"If the Son sets you free, you really will be free." JOHN 8:36
