This Week's Message: The Purpose of the Party Passage: Luke 14:1-24

Key Takeaways:

Which party guest are you? - Jesus? The Sick Man? or The Pharisees? We often think ourselves to be like Jesus, but fall into the role of the pharisee.

Where have you chosen to sit? - Jesus calls us to take the lowest seat, and He will do the exalting.

Who have you invited? - *Have you extended the invitation to those around to come to the "party" of the Gospel?*

How have you RSVP'd? - How we respond to Christ's invitation matters. He will bring His Kingdom with or without us.

Questions to Think On & Discuss:

(1) How does thinking of God's Kingdom as a celebration to invite others to change the way we view our walk with God?

(2) How does the attitude of pharisee sneak up on you in your life?

(3) How could you "Take the lowest seat" this week to show Christ's love to others?
