10-DAY DEVOTIONAL GUIDE

Exodus 3–4

**YOUR LEGACY HAS ALREADY BEEN WRITTEN.
WILL YOU STEP INTO IT?**

At some point, identity has to become obedient calling.

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

1. Read the daily Scripture slowly before listening to the audio devotional.
2. Listen without multitasking. When prompted to pause, actually pause.
3. Work through the reflection questions honestly. This is not about giving the 'right' answer.
4. Write one concrete response or act of obedience for the day.
5. End by praying the prayer prompt in your own words.

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WHEN ORDINARY BECOMES HOLY

LEGACY: IT STOPS WITH ME • Exodus 3:1–2

DAY 1

BIG IDEA

You never know when an ordinary moment or place will become a holy one.

READ

Exodus 3:1–2 — Read the passage slowly. Circle, underline, or write down anything that stands out.

REFLECT

What parts of your life feel so ordinary that you rarely expect God to meet you there?

Where have you seen God turn an ordinary place, routine, or moment into something spiritually significant?

What might you be overlooking right now because it feels too normal or repetitive?

If God interrupted your ordinary today, what would help you notice?

RESPOND

TODAY'S STEP: Choose one ordinary part of your day and enter it with this prayer: “God, help me notice You here.”

My response:

PRAY

Holy Spirit, open my eyes to where You are already moving. Turn ordinary ground into holy ground in my life.

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ARE YOU PAYING ATTENTION?

LEGACY: IT STOPS WITH ME • Exodus 3:3–4

DAY 2

BIG IDEA

God speaks when we stop to listen.

READ

Exodus 3:3–4 — Read the passage slowly. Circle, underline, or write down anything that stands out.

REFLECT

What is getting most of your attention right now?

Where have distraction, noise, or hurry made it difficult for you to listen to God?

What in your life is temporary and 'burning up' quickly? What is lasting?

If God called your name today, what would “Here I am” look like in real life?

RESPOND

TODAY'S STEP: Spend five uninterrupted minutes in silence. No phone. No music. Simply say, “Here I am,” and listen.

My response:

PRAY

God, quiet my mind. Help me pay attention, recognize Your voice, and obey what You say.

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TAKE OFF YOUR SHOES

LEGACY: IT STOPS WITH ME • Exodus 3:5–6

DAY 3

BIG IDEA

Curiosity about God must become reverence for God.

READ

Exodus 3:5–6 — Read the passage slowly. Circle, underline, or write down anything that stands out.

REFLECT

Where have you become too casual with God?

What does the fear of the Lord mean to you after reading this passage?

Is there an area of sin, worship, relationships, sexuality, words, or thought life that you have stopped treating as holy?

What would it look like for your heart and actions to 'take off your shoes' today?

RESPOND

TODAY'S STEP: Name one area where you need renewed reverence. Surrender it specifically to God.

My response:

PRAY

Holy God, teach me to fear You rightly. Forgive me for making You small. You are holy, worthy, and God.

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YOU WERE MADE ON PURPOSE

LEGACY: IT STOPS WITH ME • Exodus 3:7–10

DAY 4

BIG IDEA

Your purpose has an objective: God sends His people into the world to carry His love, truth, hope, and gospel.

READ

Exodus 3:7–10 — Read the passage slowly. Circle, underline, or write down anything that stands out.

REFLECT

What pain, injustice, loneliness, or need do you notice that other people seem to overlook?

How has something difficult in your own story shaped your compassion for others?

Who around you needs encouragement, truth, kindness, or hope today?

What might God be asking you to do instead of simply wishing someone else would do something?

RESPOND

TODAY'S STEP: Choose one person or situation where you can bring the light of Jesus today, and act.

My response:

PRAY

God, thank You that You see, hear, and know. Show me where You want to use my life in what You are already doing.

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YOU ARE NOT THE POINT

LEGACY: IT STOPS WITH ME • Exodus 3:11–12

DAY 5

BIG IDEA

Stop asking whether you are enough. God is with you.

READ

Exodus 3:11–12 — Read the passage slowly. Circle, underline, or write down anything that stands out.

REFLECT

Where do you most often think, “I am not enough”?

How can both pride and insecurity keep your attention centered on yourself?

What changes when your confidence is based on God’s presence instead of your ability?

Where do you need to replace “Who am I?” with “God is with me”?

RESPOND

TODAY'S STEP: Write down one insecurity that has been limiting you. Beside it write: “I will certainly be with you.”

My response:

PRAY

God, I turn my eyes from myself to You. When I feel inadequate, remind me that I was never meant to go alone.

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I AM

LEGACY: IT STOPS WITH ME • Exodus 3:13–15

DAY 6

BIG IDEA

Everything you are not, God is. He is the self-sufficient, unchanging I AM.

READ

Exodus 3:13–15 — Read the passage slowly. Circle, underline, or write down anything that stands out.

REFLECT

What does God's name "I AM" reveal about who He is?

What are you afraid you do not have enough of right now: strength, wisdom, courage, hope, acceptance, ability?

How does God's self-sufficiency challenge your need to control everything?

What would it look like to worship God today without asking Him for anything first?

RESPOND

TODAY'S STEP: Spend several minutes simply worshiping God for who He is, not for what you want Him to do.

My response:

PRAY

Yahweh, You are. Before anything existed, You were. I worship You as the God who needs nothing and gives life to everything.

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TRUST THE PLAYBOOK

LEGACY: IT STOPS WITH ME • Exodus 3:16–22

DAY 7

BIG IDEA

God already has a plan. He does not need you to invent one. He calls you to obey Him.

READ

Exodus 3:16–22 — Read the passage slowly. Circle, underline, or write down anything that stands out.

REFLECT

Where are you trying to write your own playbook instead of trusting what God has already said?

What part of God's plan feels difficult, slow, or confusing to you right now?

How does it change your perspective to remember that nothing that surprises you surprises God?

What is one next step God has already made clear that you need to obey?

RESPOND

TODAY'S STEP: Do not solve the next ten steps. Identify one clear step of obedience and take it.

My response:

PRAY

God, I trust Your plan. When I cannot see the whole picture, help me obey the next thing You have made clear.

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LOOK AT THE EVIDENCE

LEGACY: IT STOPS WITH ME • Exodus 4:1–9

DAY 8

BIG IDEA

Do not let today's fear make you forget yesterday's faithfulness.

READ

Exodus 4:1–9 — Read the passage slowly. Circle, underline, or write down anything that stands out.

REFLECT

What evidence of God's faithfulness can you identify in your story?

What prayers has God answered, what has He provided, or what has He changed in you?

What ordinary thing is already 'in your hand' that God might use for His purposes?

How can remembering what God has already done strengthen your obedience today?

RESPOND

TODAY'S STEP: Make a written list of at least five specific evidences of God's faithfulness in your life.

My response:

PRAY

God, bring Your faithfulness back to my memory. Help me look at the evidence instead of letting fear have the last word.

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STOP BELIEVING THE LIE

LEGACY: IT STOPS WITH ME • Exodus 4:1, 10–17

DAY 9

BIG IDEA

You must confront the internal lies before you can step into your legacy.

READ

Exodus 4:1, 10–17 — Read the passage slowly. Circle, underline, or write down anything that stands out.

REFLECT

Finish honestly: “I cannot be who God wants me to be because I am _____. ”

Where did that belief come from: a failure, comparison, someone’s words, fear, or something else?

What has God said that contradicts the identity you have been believing?

At what point has insecurity become an excuse for disobedience in your life?

RESPOND

TODAY'S STEP: Write the lie down, cross it out, and replace it with a specific truth from Scripture.

My response:

PRAY

God, show me the names and lies I have accepted that You never gave me. Teach me to believe what You say more than what I feel.

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TAKE THE FIRST STEP

LEGACY: IT STOPS WITH ME • Exodus 4:18–23

DAY 10

BIG IDEA

Your destiny is on the other side of obedience.

READ

Exodus 4:18–23 — Read the passage slowly. Circle, underline, or write down anything that stands out.

REFLECT

What is the next thing God has already made clear that you need to obey?

What comfort, fear, habit, relationship, or old identity might you need to leave behind in order to move forward?

Why do we often demand the whole plan before taking the first step?

What would taking the first step look like today, not someday?

RESPOND

TODAY'S STEP: Write your next step in one sentence. Then put a time on it: when will you do it?

My response:

PRAY

God, here I am. I do not need the whole plan. Give me enough faith to obey the next step You have already made clear.

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
