Passage: Acts 2:41-47

Key Takeaways: God's View of the Church

- (1) The Bride of Christ Ephesians 5:25-29; Il Corinthians 11:2-4; Revelations 19:7-9; 21:1-4 He has chosen us for engagement, and we are to prepare for His return.
- **(2) The Building of Christ** *Matthew 16:13-20; I Peter 2:5-8; I Corinthians 3:16-18*We measure ourselves off of the standard of Jesus Christ. Everything we do is built upon Him as the Chief Cornerstone.
- (3) The Body of Christ Ephesians 1:18; 4:15-16; Colossians 1:15-20; I Peter 4:7-11 We are His body connected, growing, and alive. We are called to be HIs hands and feet bringing Christ's love to those in need.
- (4) The Family of God I John 3:1-2; Mark 3:31; Romans 12:10-11; Galatians 3:28
