ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Let's wake up and have joy, because God loves us!"



Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, every time I think about how much You love [child's name] and me, I have joy! Thank You for loving us so much! In Jesus' name. Amen."



Drive Time

While on the go, look for animals. Each time you find an animal, name it and make the animal's sound. Talk about how Jesus told a story about a shepherd who lost an animal. It was a sheep. Jesus told this story to teach us that God loves us.



Add bubbles and a small toy sheep to bath

time. Tell your child to close their eyes while you drop the sheep in the bubbles. Then tell your child to open their eyes and find the lost sheep. Repeat. Talk about how Jesus told a story about a shepherd and his lost sheep to teach us how much God loves us.
