The DNA of the Church, as God intended it to be, will look like this:

- **COMMITTED**, to the Lord and His teaching,
- FILLED, with the Holy Spirit's presence,
- CARING for each other's real needs,
- **PRAISING** God, and finally,
- **GROWING** community.

"They committed themselves to the teaching of the apostles, the life together, the common meal, and the prayers. Everyone around was in awe—all those wonders and signs done through the apostles! And all the believers lived in a wonderful harmony, holding everything in common. They sold whatever they owned and pooled their resources so that each person's need was met. They followed a daily discipline of worship in the Temple followed by meals at home, every meal a celebration, exuberant and joyful, as they praised God. People in general liked what they saw. **Every day their number grew as God added those who were saved.**" Acts 2:42-47 (MSG)

A. Added suggests growth. Read 2 Peter 1:5-9 (Message). Church growth starts with individual growth. Growth is becoming more and more like Jesus.

B. "Every day their number grew" suggests numerical growth.

Growth should be in quality and in quantity.

C. "Added to their number daily" suggests regular growth.

Maintaining is not enough. The church corporately will not grow if the individuals of the church are not growing.

D. "Their number grew as God added those who were saved" suggests new conversion growth.

We grow as we go. We only grow to the level of our obedience.
