6. How would you explain to someone who the Holy Spirit is?

Spirit-filled living is our radical surrender to being transformed by the Holy Spirit. Read Romans 12:1-2 (Message).

7. Have you experienced the transforming power of the Holy Spirit?

8. Do you need to be filled or refilled by the Holy Spirit?
