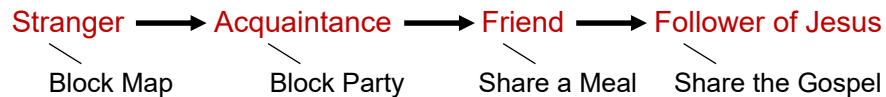
Take the **Great Commandment** literally!

What would happen if every believer at NMC made an attempt to build relationships with the people in the 8 households that are closest to them?

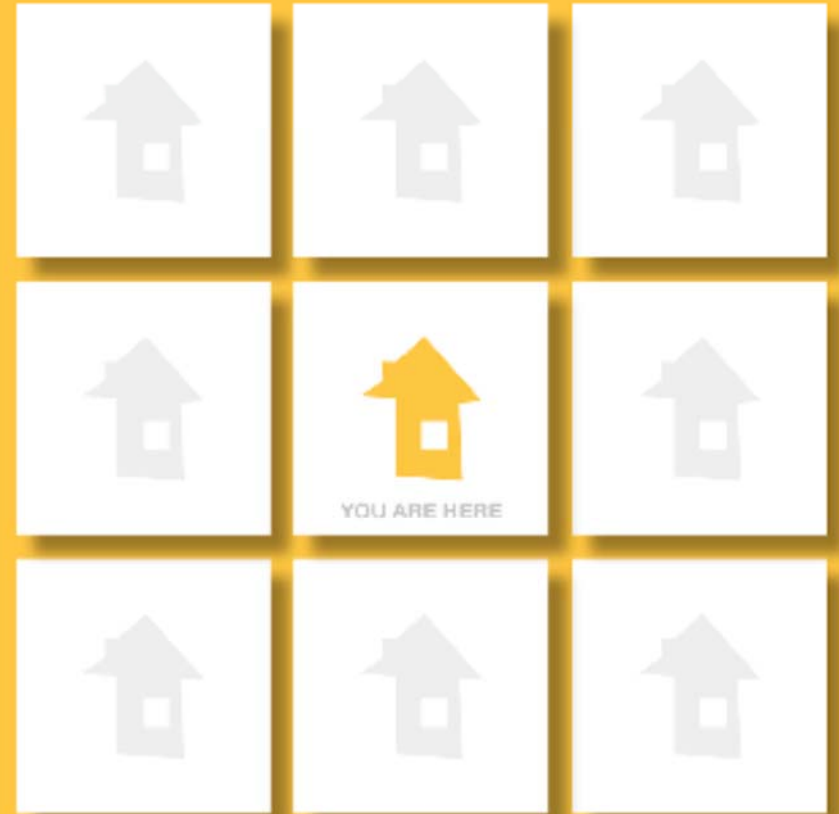


Acts 17:26-27
