Breakdown of Deuteronomy 1:

1:1-8 (see [Numbers 21:35, 36:13](#)) - timeline & setting

1:9-18 (see [Numbers 11](#)) - leaders are appointed

due to growth in population and disputes

1:19-33 (see [Numbers 13:1-24](#)) - land of Canaan spied out for 40 days

1:34-46 (see [Numbers 13:25-34](#)) - Israel refused to fight then changed their minds

Reflection Questions:

1. What are the most prominent consequences that you are still enduring to this day?
2. How have you displayed a repentant heart toward God since those mistakes? What kind of fruit have you seen that repentance bear?
3. What would it look like to endure through the current consequences you are enduring with an increased obedience to God's commands and will for your life?
4. What ways have you learned from other's mistakes? Your own?
5. How have you been able to warn others against making the same mistakes you made regarding what God considers to be sinful?
6. Which of your mistakes do you reflect upon the most when considering what God has redeemed, forgiven, and cleansed you from?
