WHY WORKS WILL NOT WORK ...

otherwise grace is no longer grace (Ephesians 2.8-10)

Central Idea: It is impossible for us to work to earn our salvation because salvation is totally of grace and nothing of human effort.

Questions for Personal Reflection or Group Discussion

- 1. We are saved through faith in Jesus. What is often added to faith that confuses the simple gospel message? (i.e., praying a certain prayer, committing your life to the Lord, etc.)
- 2. Discuss the relationship between being saved by grace and doing good works or deeds found in Eph 2.8-10. Also consider Rom 3.27-28 and Titus 2.11-14.
- 3. Why is the distinction between grace and works so easily confused even among believers?
- 4. In our efforts to understand and proclaim a free grace gospel, we should not diminish the role of doing good in our Christian lives. How can we keep both truths grace and good works in proper perspective?
- 5. Read Romans 11.6. What conclusions can we draw about grace from this verse?
