Why does **Perfection** matter?

Why does **completion** matter?

1. It is now possible for anyone to come into a right relationship with God
2. No good work we do can ever add to our salvation or earn us salvation, the debt is completely paid
3. No sin believers commit can detract from our salvation, the debt is already settled
