Bethlehem c. 1040 B.C. – DAVID (*Thirst*)
2 Samuel 23.13-17; John 4.13; Revelation 22.17

Bethlehem c. 1200 B.C. – RUTH (Love)
Ruth 1-4, esp. 1.8, 2.20, 3.10

Questions for Personal Reflection or Group Discussion

- 1. Where were you born and raised? Was it a small town where everyone knew each other or a large metropolitan city? How did this impact you during your growing up years?
- 2. Consider each of the three accounts of Bethlehem: Jesus, David and Ruth. Read the passages of Scripture and consider how the people involved and the circumstances of their lives pointed to Jesus Christ.
- 3. God is working in the details of our lives as well. How is the background of the Christmas story and God's oversight of all the details an encouragement to you as you face the circumstances of your own life?




