As you read each passage, answer these questions ...

- In this passage does the individual will of God make sense? The sovereign will? The moral will?
- Is there anything in the passage or its context that would rule out one of the three aspects of God's will?
- Which aspect of God's will do you think the biblical writer had in mind?






