Voices for Christmas: A Shepherd

## Questions for Personal or Group Consideration

- 1. When you have "big news," how do you go about sharing it with others?
- 2. Read Luke 2:8-20 and reflect on the role of the shepherds in the Christmas story. What words best describe a shepherd? (i.e., common)
- 3. Why do you think God made such an important announcement to them? What is the significance of the fact that God revealed the arrival of Jesus to shepherds?
- 4. As Jews, the shepherds probably knew something of the coming Messiah. What might they have thought about the mixed messages of "Savior," "Christ" (Messiah) and "in a feeding trough"?
- 5. How does Luke record the various responses of people in this passage? (There are at least 6 different responses.) What response don't we see?
- 6. After seeing Jesus, the shepherds spread the news and glorified God. How do you see these responses in your life today?
