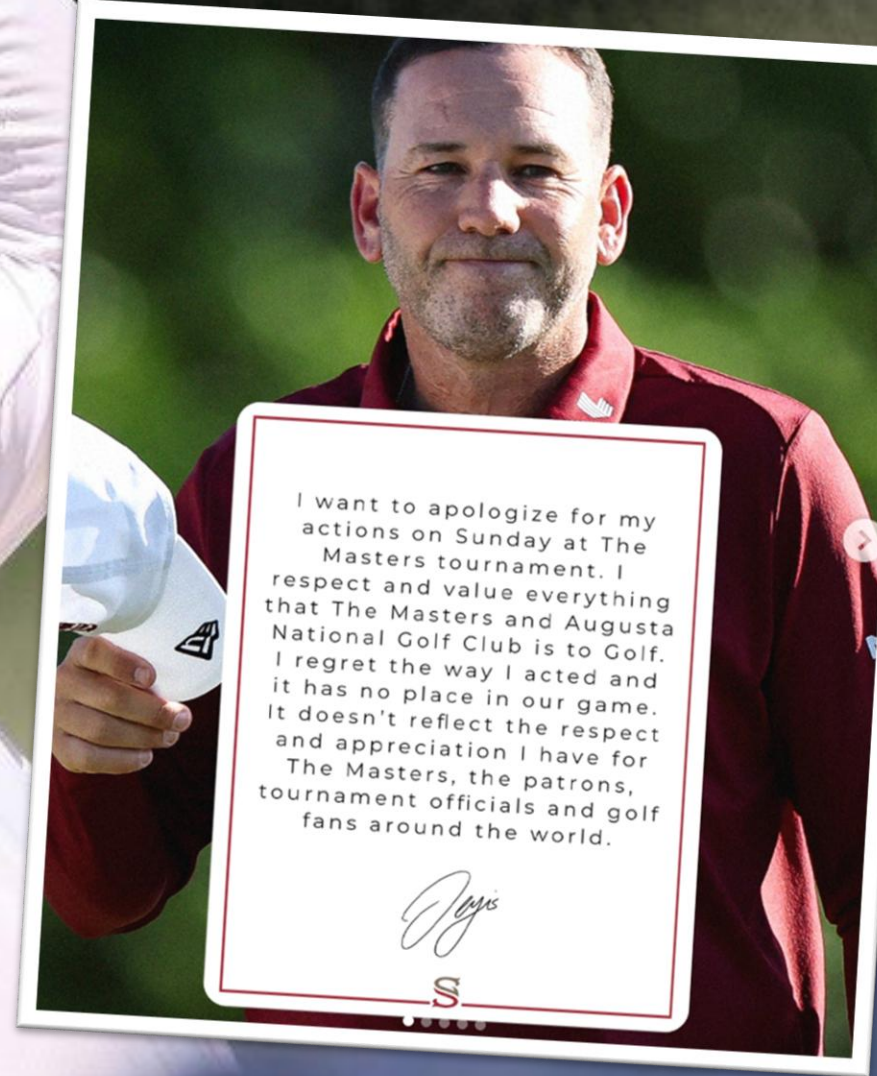

# From Sinful to Righteous Anger

Ephesians 4.26-27

- ❖ **POSITIVE COMMAND:** *be angry* (26a)
  - Anger itself is not something evil and therefore is not always sinful.
  - If we are imitators of God, we will sometimes be angry.
  - Proper anger is a sign of spiritual life and health.
