To Know and Be Fully Known

Part One: The Fellowship of the Burning Heart Luke 5:27-39

Jesus would often go to some place where He could be alone and pray. (5:16)

One day some people said to Jesus, "John the Baptist's disciples fast and pray regularly, and so do the disciples of the Pharisees. Why are your disciples always eating and drinking?" Jesus responded, "Do wedding guests fast while celebrating with the groom? Of course not. But someday the groom will be taken away from them, and then they will fast."

Use the ACTS acrostic

- Adoration
- Confession
- hanksgiving
- Supplication



Prayer and fasting are declarations that without Christ we can do nothing. And they serve as expressions of faith in God's power, fueled by a desire for more of Him. To neglect prayer is to assert our independence from God and to put our trust in our own sufficiency to meet needs.

Five Basic Principles of fasting



Steadfast and Immovable

- Full dependence in an independent world. (Proverbs 3:5, 6)
- Being fully known in an isolating world. (I Cor. 3:12)
- Embracing inadequacy in the Face of the All Sufficient One. (II Cor. 3:5)
- Consecrating ourselves to the level that "Even if you don't" (Daniel 3:16-18)
