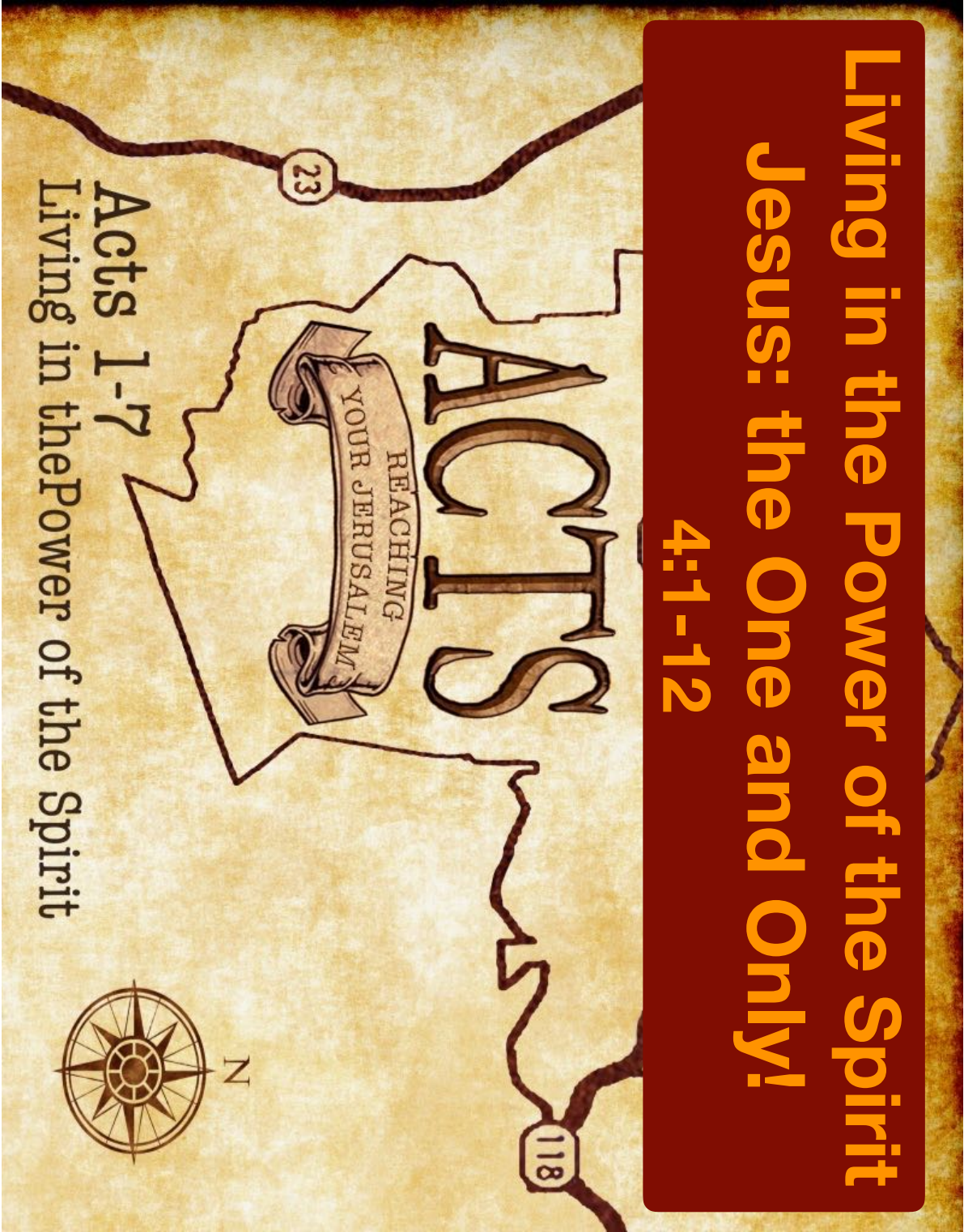

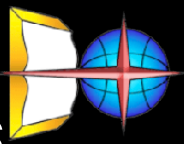


His Provision

Jesus is our *One and Only* - He . . .

- ✓ was “chosen by God” to be the Savior (1 Peter 2:4).
- ✓ came down from Heaven and returned there (Jn 3:13)
- ✓ lived a sinless human life (Hebrews 4:15)
- ✓ **is the only sacrifice for sin** (1 John 2:2; Heb. 10:26)
- ✓ fulfilled the Law and the Prophets (Matthew 5:17)
- ✓ conquered death forever (Hebrews 2:14-15)
- ✓ is the mediator between God and man (1 Tim. 2:5)
- ✓ is “exalted to the highest place” (Philippians 2:9)
