




# Looking to Jesus

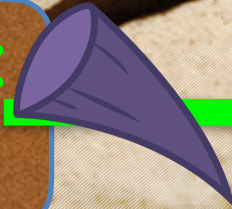

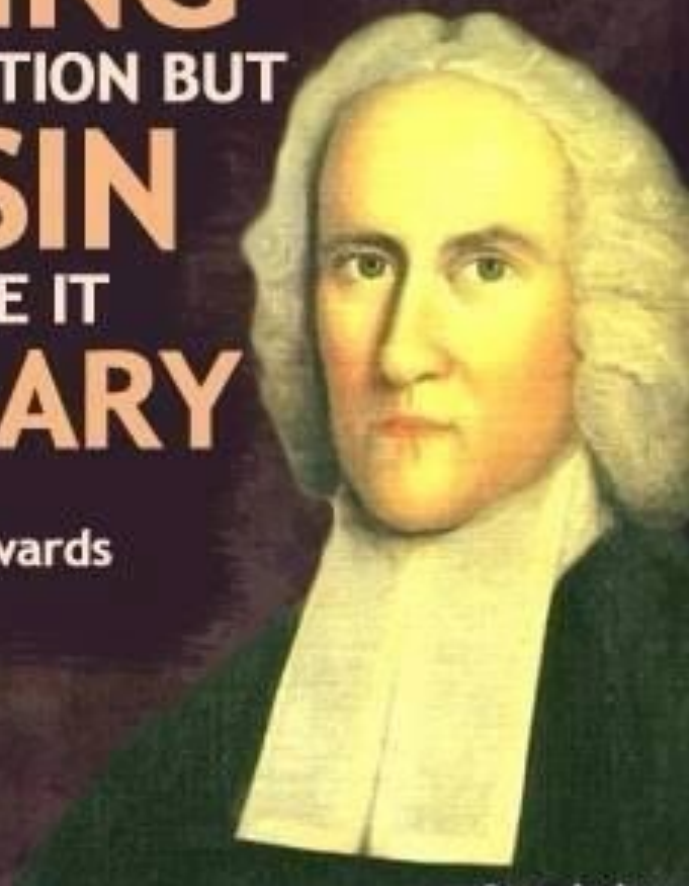
