






Looking to Jesus

Part Eighteen, Always Tasting, Never Changing! Hebrews 6:4-6









For it is impossible, in the case of those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, and have shared in the Holy Spirit, and have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the age to come, and then have fallen away, to restore them again to repentance, since they are crucifying once again the Son of God to their own harm and holding him up to contempt.



Enlightened: photizo - To illuminate, shed rays, brighten up, render evident.

Shared: metochos partaker, participant

Tasted: geuomai - to experience, to try the flavor of, to perceive

No mention of salvation, justification, sanctification, the new birth, or regeneration.




Fallen away: parapipto - To fall the Father beside a person or thing, to has given me deviate from the right path, will come to me, turn aside, wander. and I will never reject "a sustained, committed them. . . And this is the rejection of Christ and will of God, that I should not lose even one of all those he has a departure from given me, but that I should raise them the Christian up at the last day. For it is my Father's will community." that all who see his Son and believe in him ESV S.B. should have eternal life. I will raise them up at the last day." John 6:37,39-40

"To themselves:" in spite of the confession of their mouth, there was no change in their hearts. They stood with those who crucified Jesus. In their hearts they said,"That's the same verdict we give." He was not the true Messiah, so they had turned around and gone back to Judaism.




Process of Regeneration

Holy Spirit begins conviction (John 16:8)

Consideration/counting the cost (Luke 14:27-30)

> Repentance/receiving (Matthew 3:2; John 1:12)

> > Forgiveness and new life! (II Corinthians 5:17)
