#1



One man trust in himself

And treats others with contempt

Two Spiritual Profiles

#2

One wouldn't even lift his eyes to heaven

And beat his chest in repentance

And prayed the greatest prayer;
“O God, be merciful to me, for I am a sinner!”

Merciful: hilastheti - Be propitiated.
“Let your anger be removed.”





Justified: dikaiōo - To declare one to be righteous, innocent, or free!
