The Predictions of the Prophets

- 1. Messiah will have His hands and His feet "pierced" through (Psalm 22:16; John 20:25).
- 2. Messiah's bones will not be broken (usually broken after being crucified to speed up their death) (Psalm 22:17; John 19:33).
- 3. Men will cast lots for Messiah's clothing (Psalm 22:18; Matthew 27:35).
