The Mandate

Expositors Bible Commentary

The "mystery of Christ" = mysterion: A hidden or secret thing, not obvious to the understanding. The Death, burial and resurrection of Jesus, making Jew and Gentile one with God and one another.

Made known by revelation = apokalypsis: laying bear, making naked; a disclosure of truth concerning things before unknown.

All truth is made known by God. There is no truth that originates from us. The Holy Spirit opens the eyes of our heart to the truth of Scripture (Eph. 1:18).


The Manifold Wisdom of God

"manifold" = polupoikilos: multi-facited and multicolored. God's wisdom in salvation is filled with beautiful variety; shades, tints, hues, and color. Through the cross of Christ, God has called Jews and Gentiles, slaves and free, men and women, rich and poor from every nation, language and people group. And, He makes this display using His church (that's us!). (Galatians 3:28; Rev. 5:9)

Church - ekklesia: Called out ones; A gathering of citizens called out from their homes into some public place; an assembly of Christians gathered for worship in a religious meeting.
