


In need of care

Greek word *kalos* translated "good" describes that which is noble, wholesome, good, and beautiful.



The "hired hand" - runs from trouble and abandons the sheep to wolves because he doesn't really care about the sheep. The Good Shepherd runs toward the threat and rescues His sheep because He cares for them.

Sacrifice

The good shepherd sacrifices his life for the sheep. . . . So I sacrifice my life for the sheep.
