Q: Is there an area in which you consider yourself to be an “expert?” Do you enjoy sharing your knowledge or skill with others?

Q: Do you tend to start books and never finish? Or begin projects that never get completed? Or are you strong in following through with these things?

READ: Hebrews 6:4-6

Q: The audience for our passage clung to their Jewish roots in hopes of justification by their religious works. What are some things folks still do to try to “earn salvation?” (Eph. 2:8, 9)

Q: To be “enlightened” brings the intellectual knowledge of the truth. To be enlightened is to be accountable for the truth. Do you tend to believe grace but live works? Do you think this is common?

Q: Those who have “tasted” have been first-hand witnesses to the grace of God in His church. Are there truths in God’s word that you have “tasted” but never internalized?

Q: Based on this passage, do you think there might be value in preaching the gospel on a regular basis in the church? How can you “live” the gospel in ways that draw lost church-goers into personal relationship with Christ?

GROUP TIME: *Ask the Lord to teach His church to love Him with our “heart, soul, strength, and mind.” (Read Luke 10:25-28)*
