Luke 1:37 For with God nothing shall be impossible.

As we have passed through Christmas it is truly the greatest time to believe. A time to believe in miracles, to expect great things and to see the handiwork of God like never before. The spirit of giving, loving, and being utterly nice to people is at an all-time high. At this particular point in time of scripture there was stillness, waiting and wanting, much like there is today. They were waiting on the promise of the messiah, this was something that only God could bring to pass. No man, no woman, nobody could give the help and the hope this world needed. Only God.

Hope was coming, hope was on the way!

I want us to talk about this word impossible for just a moment.

The Greek word is #101 adunateo – ad-oo-nat-eh'-o which means to be unable, impossible, be impossible. That means that it will not, can't and won't be done. AKA, not gonna happen. However, in this verse it says that nothing will be impossible with God. That means with God it is very possible!

Matthew 17:20 And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

I want to look at another version now. This one is #102 adunatos which means unable because of your weakness, and ties in with #1415 dunatos which implies strength. So this next verse says you can't do it because your weak in the flesh.

Matthew 19:26 But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.

The disciples asked the question in verse 25 and said who then can be saved and Jesus responded in verse 26 and said I can. I can save from the richest to the poorest, from the Kings to the nobles, from the uttermost to the gutter most. There are none outside of his reach. However, with this being said we find the next verse:

Romans 8:3-4 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: 4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Now we understand that the impossible can become possible through the spirit of GOD dwelling in us, what was once impossible now becomes possible, whether it's through the flesh and its limitations, which bring about questions, and concerns, our moments of doubt and unbelief will all fade away when the KING OF GLORY STEPS IN. So here in Luke 1:37 leading into this scripture we have Zacharias and Elisabeth who are barren and the angel speaks and says you gonna have a baby, the angel is questioned by the flesh and the flesh is now unable to speak. BUT, **The promise still comes.** Then we have Mary and Joseph, angel speaks and again questioned in the flesh by Mary when she says but how can this be seeing I know not a man. The angel responds in verse 35-Read verse: basically it says that when the Holy Ghost gets on you, things will change. Verse 38 brings it home for everybody when Mary said then bring it and the promise comes. This must be our answer as well, there is a world that is waiting and wanting and looking for something. They don't need another 2 step plan or a govt fix, they need JESUS!

The KING of GLORY. Hope has come and hope is here. He is the GOD OF IMPOSSIBILTIES!!!! He is the God of right now, he is the God of a suddenly moment, He is an on time GOD!
