Philippians 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.

I want to focus on the words of <u>think on these things</u>. What are these things that Paul is talking about? Let's look at the entire book of Philippians, (introduction) then the specific chapter breakdown on Ch. 4

- 1. True
 - a. Truth, truthful
 - i. Ephesians 4:25 Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbor: for we are members one of another.
- 2. Honest
 - a. To be venerated for character, honorable
 - i. 2 Corinthians 8:21 Providing for honest things, not only in the sight of the Lord, but also in the sight of men.
- 3. Just
 - a. in a wide sense, upright, righteous, virtuous, keeping the commands of God
 - i. Deuteronomy 16:20 That which is altogether just shalt thou follow, that thou mayest live, and inherit the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.
- 4. Pure
 - a. pure from carnality, chaste, modest
 - i. 1 Thessalonians 5:22 Abstain from all appearance of evil.
- 5. Lovely
 - a. acceptable, pleasing.
 - i. 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, 5 Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; 6 Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth; 7 Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.
- 6. Good Report
 - a. sounding well
- 7. Virtue
 - a. behavior showing high moral standards.
- 8. Praise
 - a. express warm approval or admiration of.
