# Blessed - Sermon 8 - Peace and War Matthew 5:9-12

#### TEXT: Matthew 5:9–12 (ESV)

<sup>9</sup> "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God. <sup>10</sup> "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. <sup>11</sup> "Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. <sup>12</sup> Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

## 1. What is a Peacemaker?

<sup>9</sup> "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.

A peacemaker is one who has found peace with God through Christ and seeks to bring others into that same peace.

## 2. Why does it always bring persecution?

#### 2 Corinthians 2:15-16 (ESV)

<sup>15</sup> For we are the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing, <sup>16</sup> to one a fragrance from death to death, to the other a fragrance from life to life.

## 3. Why should we rejoice when Persecuted?

### 1 Peter 3:14-17 (ESV)

<sup>14</sup> But even if you should suffer for righteousness' sake, you will be blessed. Have no fear of them, nor be troubled, <sup>15</sup> but in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect, <sup>16</sup> having a good conscience, so that, when you are slandered, those who revile your good behavior in Christ may be put to shame. <sup>17</sup> For it is better to suffer for doing good, if that should be God's will, than for doing evil.
