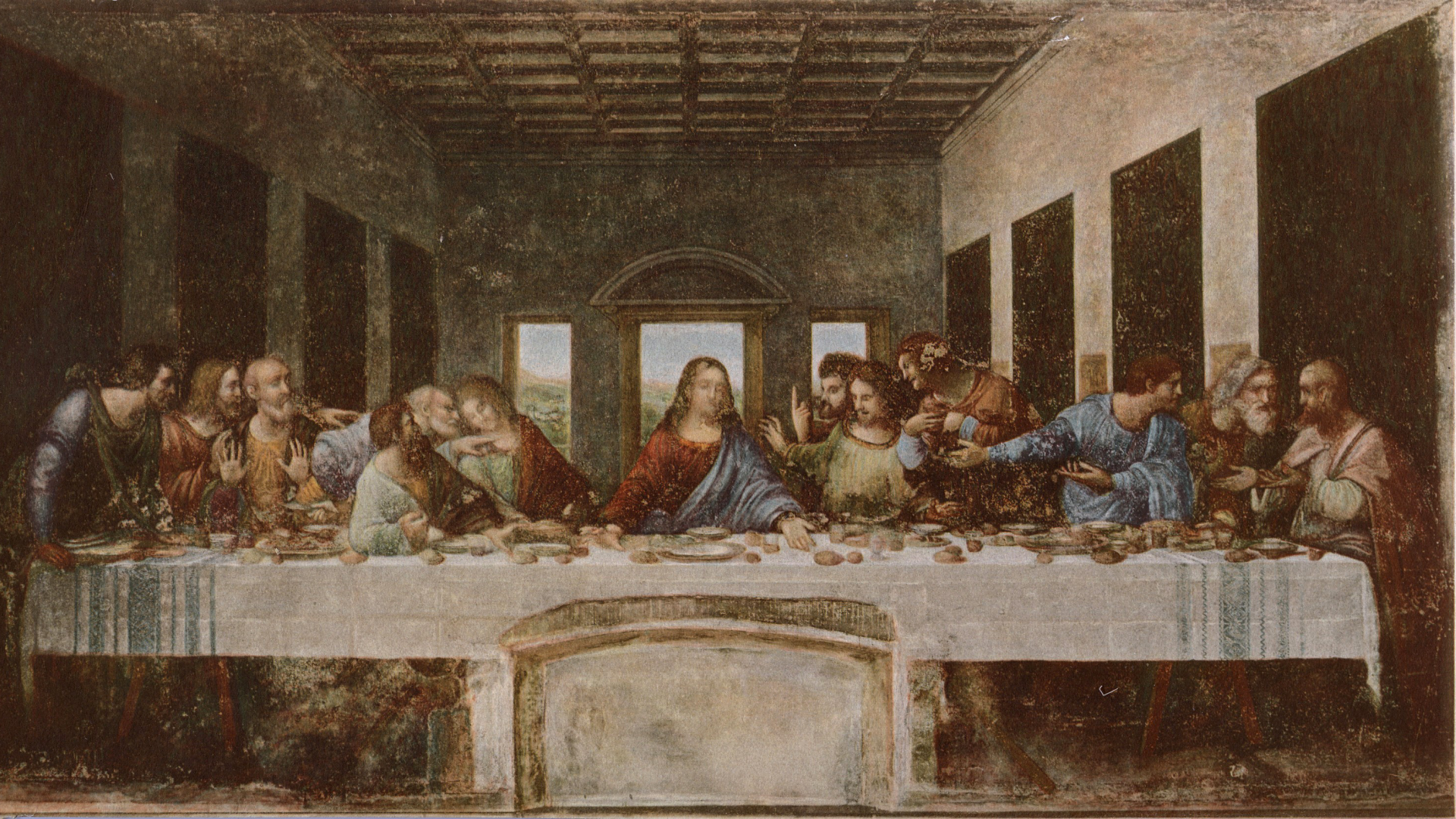
Every year to commemorate
