

The Lord is near. Don't worry about anything, but in everything, through prayer and petition with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.



Hope - confident expectation and certainty that what God has promised in the Word is true, has occurred, and or will occur in accordance with His Word

Confident Assurance that He Will

- Receive us into glory to be with Him eternally. (Jn 14)
- Give us a new body in a new heavenly kingdom. (1 Cor 15)
- Always be gracious and forgive us abundantly. (1 Jn 1:9)

- Never abandon us or forsake us but will be with us in all things. (Mt 28:20)
- Reward us for faithfulness. (Mt 25:31-40)
- Supply our every true need (Mt 6:25-33)
- Give us everything we need for life and godliness. (2 Peter 1:3)
- Be strong on our behalf when we are weak. (2 Cor. 12:9-10)

- Gift us with spiritual gifts through His indwelling Holy Spirit so that we can be the church he intended. (1 Cor. 12)
- Be found when we seek Him with our whole heart. (Jer 29:13)
 Work all things for our good and his glory.
