4 a. Do you believe God exists?

If He does, then sin is your greatest problem – and having your sins forgiven is your greatest need.

4 b. Do you believe Jesus is God?

- He knows what you're thinking every moment – v.8
- He heals/creates with His word(s) – vv. 10,11
