The Nature of Fulfilled Prophecy

 We'll be most likely to recognize it when it is "here"/fulfilled – not necessarily before it's unfolding

Luke 12:40

"You also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect Him."

v. 4 "John the Baptist appeared"

v. 15 "The time is fulfilled"

The ultimate solution to the world's problems is the ultimate expression and extension of God's Kingdom; and yet, before its total and complete coming, His kingdom is no less here and no less expanding

Making sure we don't miss it/Him

Living in repentance and faith

Repentance = our mindset/heartset toward our sin

Faith = our mindset/heartset toward God's provision of forgiveness

It's how we're saved and it's how we stay ready

Acts 20:21 "I have declared to both Jews and Greeks that they must turn to God in repentance and have faith in our Lord Jesus."

Acts 2:38,39 "Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off - for all whom the Lord our God will

2. Followers Fish (v.17)

Fishing for fishers – v.17

Sowing for sowers – Luke 13:19

Preaching for preachers (v.14; "voice" vv. 3,7,11 - Luke 9:2; Matt. 10:7)

1. Live it out

2. Sow the seeds – words, actions, invitations, service (actively LOVE)

3. Harvest – Pull the full net into the boat (teach, train and send)
