1. Refuse to submit to God and His Word as your authority

2. Stubbornly refuse to change your presuppositions, even in the face of all evidence, truth and logic to the contrary – vv. 23-27

3. Grasp for and end up embracing
damnable conclusions 180 degrees from
life and goodness – vv. 29 & 30
