Jehovah Jireh – God revealed as The LORD who provides – seeing every need in advance and preparing for it before it arrives.

Four Postures That Position Us for God’s Provision

1. Availability (Genesis 22:1)

- God called Abraham, and Abraham responded, “Here I am.” Before anything else happened, Abraham had to be present and available.

Discuss:

- *In the pace of everyday life, what tends to crowd out your ability to notice when God is speaking?*
- *What might it look like for you to create more space to respond to God with “Here I am”?*

2. Obedience (Genesis 22:3)

- Availability without obedience is just lip service. Abraham didn’t just hear God. He got up early and acted on what God asked him to do.

Discuss:

- *Why do you think it can be difficult to move from hearing God’s direction to actually obeying it?*
- *How might your life look different if you responded to God’s prompting with immediate obedience?*

3. Trust (Genesis 22:5; Genesis 22:8)

- Abraham was able to reassure Isaac that God would provide. That confidence came from years of walking with God and seeing His faithfulness.

Discuss:

- *Who are the people in your life that help remind you of God’s faithfulness when things feel uncertain?*



- *How have past experiences with God helped strengthen your trust in Him today?*

4. Surrender (*Genesis 22:9–10; Genesis 22:14*)

- While Abraham and Isaac were walking up the mountain, God was already providing the ram on the other side. Provision was already in motion, even when they couldn't see it yet.

Discuss:

- *Where in your life is God asking you to surrender control and trust Him more fully?*
- *How might believing that God is already at work ahead of you change the way you approach that situation?*
