Yahweh: A Definition

- God reveals Himself as Yahweh through His covenant faithfulness, redemption, and constant presence with His people.

Discuss:

- *How have you personally seen God show His faithfulness, redemption, and presence in your life?*
- *God's faithfulness often becomes most visible during pressure. When have you felt God's presence most clearly in a difficult season?*

God Makes Himself Known To His People

- Moses is showing up to say, "Yahweh is saying let His people go" as a covenant reminder. It's easy to be there on a good day, but not so easy on a hard one. (Exodus 34:6-7)

Discuss:

- *God's character is revealed in Exodus. Which part of His character in these verses stands out most to you right now?*
- *Exodus also shows patterns that can carry across generations. Is there anything from previous generations you're trying to overcome or break free from?*

God Proves Who He Is To His People

- God shows that everything begins with who He is, not the situation we are in. (Exodus 6:6-7)

Discuss:

- *God doesn't require us to fix ourselves before coming to Him. What does this mean to you?*
- *Is there someone that feels out of reach right now that we can pray for?*

Application

- In the New Testament, Jesus comes in the flesh, bringing salvation and revealing God fully to us. (John 8:58; John 1:14; John 6:38–40; John 14:18)

Discuss:

- *Jesus declares that He is Yahweh and promises the Holy Spirit to be with us. How have you experienced this promise personally?*
