- FOURTH YOU MUST INTENSELY DESIRE THE FILLING/AND OR BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT
- LAST YOU MUST SIMPLY PRAY AND ASK JESUS TO BAPTIZE YOU IN THE HOLY SPIRIT



Conversation starter. Start light and fun conversation in your group about the series topic.

• You have to where a T-shirt with one word on it for one year. What word do you choose and why? (i.e. I choose mushroom because I'm a fungi, or I choose husband because I love my wife and don't want other women to try any funny business)

Contemplate. Ask questions to get your group thinking about these principles.

• Read John 14:12-14; 20:21-22; Acts 1:4-5; 2:15-21, 38-39; 19:1-3; 7:51; 1 Corinthians 12:13. Have the group list some ways the Holy Spirit operates. (i.e. 1 Corinth says He baptizes us into one Body)

Contribute. Ask questions that create personal openness in your group.

• Do you have a personal relationship with the Holy Spirit? Explain the why or why not of your relationship with Him.

Cry out to God. Pray intensely for your group on the topic.

Jesus, thank You for saving our souls. We confess and repent of all the sin in our lives right now. We completely surrender to all You have for us. We want and desire baptism in the Holy Spirit. So, Jesus, please baptize us in the Holy Spirit from the top of our heads to the bottom of our feet, so that we can be Your hands and feet like never before and walk in power for Your glory. In Jesus name. Amen.

Commit to change. What's a new area to grow with the Lord?

- I will pray and ask Jesus to baptize me in the Holy Spirit this week.
- I will spend 10 minutes in quiet anticipation each day listening for the Holy Spirit's voice.
