## Series scripture - Hebrews 11

**1. What is faith?** Faith is complete trust or confidence in someone or something.

Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it is the evidence of things we cannot see. - Hebrews 11:1 (NLT)

Now Faith is the substance of the things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. - Hebrews 11:1 (KJV)

### 2. Where is faith?

For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that these things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. 24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them. - Mark 11:23-24 (NKJV)

that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. - Romans 10:9-10 (NKJV)

## 3. How do we operate in faith?

(as it is written, "I have made you a father of many nations") in the presence of Him whom he believed—God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did;

Romans 4:17 (NKJV)

And without faith is impossible to please God, because anyone who approaches Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him.

## 4. Sarah stayed in her place of faith
