Meditation Verse

"Let your conversation be gracious and effective so that you will have the right response for everyone." Colossians 4:6 NLT

Communication actually means "to have in common."

Communication in its most basic form is simply the exchange of information and ideas, whether verbal or nonverbal.

Communication Guidelines

- a. Be alert and be able to read the situation before you dive into a conversation. John 16:13 ESV
- b. Listening is the single most important of all the communication skills. James 1:19 AMP

c. Show an interest in other people. Let each of you look not only to his own interest, but also to the interest of others. - Philippians 2:4 ESV

Communication Through Conflict

a. Don't avoid conflict with the silent treatment. Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. - Ephesians 4:15 NIV

b. When conflict happens, be quick to decide when the best time would be to talk about it. Especially if the conversation is very heated. Ephesians 4:26

c. Stay on one topic at a time. (Don't bring up the past.)

3 Techniques For Productive Communication

- 1. "I" and "you" messages Help me understand...
- 2. The Compliment Sandwich
- 3. Active listening Repeat back to the person what you think you heard them say.
