7 Application Tips for Walking in Forgiveness

1. Check Your Heart Daily

"Search me, O God..." (Ps 139:23)

2. Speak Forgiveness Out Loud

3. Stop Rehearsing the Offense

"Love keeps no record of wrongs..." (1 Cor. 13:5)

4. Pray for the Person Who Hurt You

"Bless those who curse you..." (Luke 6:28)

5. Remember How Much You've Been Forgiven

"Forgive as the Lord forgave you..." (Col. 3:13)

6. Set Healthy Boundaries (When Needed)

"Guard your heart..." (Prov. 4:23)

7. Celebrate the Freedom Forgiveness Brings

"It is for freedom that Christ has set us free..." (Gal. 5:1)
